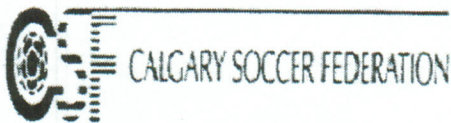

POSITIONING IS EXEMPLARY. FOUL RECOGNITION, USE OF WHISTLE & ARM SIGNALS ARE ALSO REALLY GOOD. YOUR WHISTLE TONE IS A LITTLE MONOTONE IN THAT EACH USE, WHETHER A FOUL OR A SIMPLE RE-START IS A LOW SHRILL BLAST. WHILST THIS IS A GOOD START (USUALLY WE ASK FOR MEEK WHISTLES TO BE LOUDER) IT DOES RENDER THE BIG CALLS A LITTLE LACKING IN RECOGNITION - THE IMPACT OF A STEAD WHISTLE IS TAKEN AWAY. OTHER THAN THIS BASH CORRECTION, YOUR GAME IS VERY SOUND INDEED.
