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Return to Modified Games

Mandatory Risk Assessment and Webinar – You should familiarize yourself with the <u>Alberta Soccer Phase 2 – Return to Modified Games</u> document. This document will help make everything else make sense. One person on your team must complete the CSA Risk Assessment and watch the <u>Alberta Soccer Webinar</u> prior to playing this season.

Modified Game Rule Changes – CUSA rules and regulations have been updated to reflect modifications to CUSA rules to align with the Modified Game that we are currently hosting. Facility Guidelines – Facilities have adjusted their operating procedures for this season to align with recommendations from AHS. Please review the facility guidelines below carefully, and ensure your players are aware and have familiarized themselves with each facility they will be playing at.

- Calgary Soccer Centre
- Genesis Centre
- Macron Fieldhouse (formerly Foothills Fieldhouse)
- Calgary West Soccer Centre

Confirm with the operating procedures of the facility you are playing at prior to leaving for the game. Some facilities, teams must meet outside and enter the building all at once. Some facilities will not have dressing rooms available etc. These operating procedures will be updated if needed and available on the CUSA website under <u>Facility and Field Information</u>

Pre-Game and Post Game Procedures – Prior to each game, when all players who are participating have arrived, read out the <u>pre-game symptom checklist</u> and record the answers. The team must keep a copy of the checklist, dated the date of the game, for a minimum of 30 days. This <u>Coach Checklist</u> can help coaches and team managers stay organized and remember to bring new items, such as supplies to sanitize game balls.

Training Week Isolation– When your team is in training week with 14 days of no games, you may choose to train with only those individuals listed on your team roster but be aware that Cohort rules still apply to practices and scrimmages.

It is imperative that you accurately contact trace your practices and have **each player** complete a <u>pre-game symptom checklist</u> and keep that checklist for 30 days. This ensures you have accurate information should AHS require it for contact tracing. To use the contact tracing log provided by Alberta Soccer, <u>click here</u>. Game Sheets are suitable replacements of the contact tracing log for league games.

Player Registration

Beginning October 13th. Teams will receive an email when their team has been activated in RAMP, at that time, any and all players on the team invite list will receive an email invitation to register. Alternatively, teams can give their players the team registration link OR invite code to complete registration without an invitation email. - Roster Maximum of 22 names this season, including coaches.
- Player registration is online only, paper registration forms are not acceptable this season
 due to the additional COVID-19 Waivers required for this season. Players must register
 online prior to picking up their new player card, if they need one. There is a guide for player
 registration that you can direct your players to under the <u>RAMP User Guides</u>, linked on the
 homepage and under the resources menu.
- The CUSA office will be open to accommodate those who need new cards.
- If a player comes to the office prior to registering, they will have to register on their phone, or the computer we have available in the office. To help keep the process streamlined and efficient, we strongly encourage all players to register prior to arriving in the office.
- At the time of registration, all players are required to pay their \$8 ASA/CSA affiliation fee.

Game Sheets

CUSA will not be providing teams with the traditional CUSA gamesheets, instead teams will print their game sheet off prior to the game, pre-filled with your players names, ID numbers and jersey numbers. Instructions for printing the game sheets are on the website and <u>linked here</u>. You will not be able to access your team login until closer to league play commencing – the RAMP system will send you an email with the team login information in 2-3 weeks time.

Managers Meeting (Virtual)

There will be two opportunities to login to a virtual managers meeting and Q&A Session with CUSA Staff.

- October 22 12:00pm to 1:00pm
- October 29 5:00pm to 6:00pm

Logging into the meeting is not mandatory, however we will go over everything that has been covered in this email, and will have a Q&A at the end to answer questions about the season and/or player registration and RAMP Software. Links to the meeting with an Agenda will be sent to team managers in the coming weeks.

Schedule of Games

League schedules are targeted to be released the week ending October 23rd. Schedule requests are extremely difficult to accommodate this season, best efforts are made when the schedule is created however reschedules will not be available this season due to cohort restrictions.

Fee Deadline

Team fees are due in full by November 1, 2020. Payment will be made available online no later than October 13th.
