To All Interested Applicants:

On behalf of the Calgary Women's Fastpitch Association (CWFA) Executive, thank you for your interest in the CWFA Post Secondary Scholarship Program. Many Alberta women have benefited from this program in the pursuit of their academic studies.

Please take the time to read through the criteria and application form carefully and thoroughly. Here are some items to be aware of:

- An individual may be awarded any CWFA scholarships a collective maximum of four times.
- CWFA Scholarship Committee will select the successful applicant and all decisions will be final.
- A maximum of four (4) scholarships are made available per year (2 CWFA, 1 Don Beyak Memorial, 1 – Gary Bockman Memorial). If there are insufficient quality applications for the scholarships in a given year, the number of scholarships awarded that year may be reduced.
- Applications which are incomplete or insufficient in any way will <u>not</u> be considered.
- Fax and email transmissions will <u>not</u> be accepted.

CWFA SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Residency / Association Requirements:

- 1. The applicant must be a current Alberta resident.
- 2. The applicant must be a member in good standing of the Calgary Women's Fastpitch Association.
- 3. The applicant <u>must</u> be a member in good standing of Softball Alberta.

Academic Requirements:

- 1. The applicant <u>must</u> be registered in a post secondary institution to continue studies towards a diploma, certificate or degree. Proof of current (upcoming year) registration <u>must</u> be submitted with the application.
- The applicant <u>must</u> have attained a minimum average of 70% in her previous year of studies. Proof of marks must be received by the CWFA scholarship committee by the deadline.
- 3. CWFA <u>must</u> receive, by the deadline, an <u>official</u> copy of your previous year's transcript of subjects/marks, from your high school, the appropriate Ministry of Education, or your post secondary education institution.

Fastball Requirements:

- 1. The applicant <u>must</u> have a great attitude towards the game of fastpitch.
- 2. The applicant <u>must</u> be on the current official roster of a CWFA team for both league and provincial play.
- 3. The application <u>must</u> be complete in all respects, and <u>must</u> include a 400-to-500-word essay outlining what fastpitch has done for you and what and how you have given back to the sport.
- 4. A letter of reference from your head coach is required.
