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- Up to 65 people are permitted for game including players, coaches, 2 safety people, timekeeper, scorekeeper, 2 Penalty Box, managers, 2 host and 2 video streamers. No Spectators regardless of numbers.
- There will be no spectators
- All players and coaches arrive 20 minutes prior to game
- Players dressed prior to coming to arena, so there is no delay in the game. Goalies are the exception and may finish dressing at the arena.
- Prior to the game, a list of the opposition's team name and contact information for everyone entering the rink for that game.
- Covid- 19 prescreening should be done by the visiting team before coming to the arena. Visiting team is expected to follow their organizations COVID-19 plan and do their pre-screening before the event.
- There will be no OFF-ICE WARM UP inside the Arena.
- 2 hosts preferred. One host will be responsible for the Home team and the second host be responsible for the Away team
- Arena Staff or previous Door Greeter will only open the door for the host.
- Hosts will arrive at 20 mins prior to game and will be responsible for everyone entering the building. They are also to confirm that only people listed are entering the arena.
- Front Doors will remain locked.
- Both teams will be entering and using change rooms on the same side of rink.
- When the opposing team arrives; Visitor Host will direct them where to stand outside on the East side of the arena wait until the host states that it is safe to enter the building, 15 mins prior to the game.
- When the home team arrives, Home Host will direct them where to stand outside on the West side of the arena until it is safe to enter the building- 15 minutes prior to the game
- The Host will lead the home team first and take the south dressing room and then the visitor host will lead the opposing team to the north dressing room
- Referees - Once all players and coaches have entered the building the host can let in the refs. The refs will come as dressed as possible, Refs can use the middle hallway chairs to put on skates and such. They will also have access to the sick room for washrooms and if they need to change or have a safe place in between periods. We ask refs to not keep anything in the sick room as if it is needed, their belongings would be contaminated.
- The hosts then will let in the rest of the volunteers. Timekeeper, Scorekeeper, Safety and Video streamers.
- Hand Sanitizer station is provided when you enter the arena.
- Managers, Safety people, Door greeters and Video Streamers will enter the bleachers on the side that the players are on. They will sit in the designated marked off spots in the stands to properly social distance. Video Streamers can set-up, up top behind the bleachers.
  - If any of the volunteers need to go to the benches or dressing rooms or cannot maintain social distance mask are to be worn.
- Timekeeper, scorekeeper and penalty box personal will need to access the timekeeper box from the bleachers. Masks must be worn in the Timekeeper box and in the Penalty Boxes.
- All Coaches/players must wear masks inside the Dressing room and entering/exiting the Arena. Coaches were Masks
  - Coaches must wear masks on bench
- They will be a designated sick room, if a player needs to be isolated. This Dressing Room will be the middle Dressing room on the side that the Players are changing on.
- Refs will enter onto the ice through the middle gate.
- The teams can enter the ice surface once the refs are on the ice.
- When there is a flood the refs will Exit through the middle gate.
- Volunteers will exit as soon as the game is over.
- All Coaches and players need to exit the arena within 15 mins of game ending
- There will not be showers available.
- Visiting Host will make sure Visiting team has completely exited then Home team Host will allow for the Home team to exit
- The Coaches will be the last to leave the dressing rooms. Dressing rooms to be clean when coaches leave
- The hosts will be checking off that each person has exited the building. Exit building same side as entered.
- There will be no loitering outside the arena doors after the game.



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# Participant Agreement

Application- all athletes, coaches, members, volunteers, participants and family members of participants while in attendance at association activities (“participants”)

All Participants of Dawson Creek Minor Hockey Association and Visiting Teams agree abide by the following points when participating in hockey activities under the COVID-19 Response Plan and RTP Protocol.

- I agree to symptom screening checks, and will let my association know if I have experienced any of the COVID-19 symptoms in the last 14 days.
- I agree to stay home if feeling sick, and remain home for 14 days if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
- I agree to sanitize my hands upon entering and exiting the facility, with soap or sanitizer
- I agree to sanitize the equipment I use throughout my practice with approved cleaning products provided
- I agree to continue to follow social distancing protocols of staying 2m away from others
- I agree not to share any equipment during practice times
- I agree to abide by all of DCMHA COVID policies and guidelines
- I understand that if I do not abide by the aforementioned policies/guidelines, that I may be asked to leave the association for up to 14 days to help protect myself and others around me
- I acknowledge that continued abuse of the policies/guidelines may result in suspension of my association membership temporarily
- I acknowledge that there are risks associated with entering the City of Dawson Creek arena’s and/or participating in hockey association activities, and that the measures taken by the association and participants, including those set out above and under the COVID-19 response plan and return to sport protocols, will not entirely eliminate those to risk.
