#### Alberta Community Facility Enhancement Program (CFEP)

CFEP funding provides financial assistance to acquire, build, purchase, repair, renovate, upgrade or expand sports, recreational, cultural or other related public-use community facilities. CFEP Small Funding stream maximum funding request is \$125,000. Organizations may be considered for up to \$10,000 non-matching funding (See section 5.6 of the <a href="CFEP Guidelines">CFEP Guidelines</a>

#### Baseball Alberta Facility Grant Program

The maximum grant available to any one Association for any one project in a year will be \$15,000 to assist member Associations in having the facilities necessary to support the continued growth and development of baseball across the province.
