## a. President Report

- Many tournaments were attended at all levels; a highlight was having 3 teams together in Lethbridge!
- Very impressive coaching staff this season (particularly having teenage lacrosse players mentor our younger kids)!
- Looking strong going into playoffs (still a couple games left to play this week-end; all levels are looking at possible Top 6 finishes for League)
- Playoffs are up-coming for all levels (except Mini); Novice play in Lacombe on June 22-23;
   Peewee will be in Stettler June 22-23; Bantams and Midgets are TBD
- DLA will not be participating in Provincials for 2019
- For an efficient board, it would be beneficial to fill the president role

#### f. Discipline Report

Relatively quiet year. No official complaints

3 unofficial complaints.

-Two from spectators regarding player foul language during games (one bantam and one midget).

-One regarding players behaviour in the dressing room (bantam). Both dealt with by VP's without official sanctions.

Three, 2 game suspensions handed out by CALL for in-game rule violations.

- -Two for the midget team (the first for rules 64, slashing & rule 50, high sticking) (and second for rule 38, checking from behind).
- -One for the bantam team (rule 57, kicking a player).

As of June 12 Didsbury 2019 season total PIMs are:

Novice = 48 (league average is 59). Ranked #11 of 13 teams for most PIMs. Peewee = 123 (league average is 98). Ranked #2 of 11 teams for most PIMs. Bantam = 161 (league average is 169). Ranked #5 of 9 teams for most PIMs. Midget = 270 (league average is 252). Ranked #3 of 8 teams for most PIMs.
