Here is most of the info you will need for the 2019 Season. Please do not private message board members for info that can be found on the website

1 - Equipment needed:

Rally Cap & Grand Slam (9U)– Players are sponsored by national sponsorship programs. Each player will receive a jersey and hat that they get to keep. Please wear runners, and black sweats, track pants or leggings – NO SHORTS, SANDALS OR CROCS. Each players needs to bring their own glove, batting helmet and water bottle.

11U (Mosquito), 13U (Pee wee) & 15U (Bantam) – Players need to wear black baseball pants, cleats, Jock or Jill and a Black Dauphin ‘D’ ball cap (See #5 in this document). – NO SHORTS, SANDALS OR CROCS All players need to have their own glove and batting helmet with strap. Players can bring their own bat to games but please check with your coach to make sure it is a legal bat. Team jersey fittings will be during one of your indoor practices in the last week of April.

2 – Fundraiser:

Rally Cap Coaches:

- Respect in Sport: expires every 5 years so make sure you are up to date. Follow the RIS link then send your certificate number to Jodie
- NCCP – Coach Initiation in Baseball online module, Rally Cap Initiation Program on line (taken right after you complete coach initiation in baseball on line module, then sign up for the in person clinic being held Saturday May 4th 8:30am-12:30pm @ the Rotary arena

All other Coaches:

- Respect in Sport: expires every 5 years so make sure you are up to date. Follow the RIS link then send your certificate number to Jodie
- NCCP – Coach Initiation in Baseball online modules, then sign up for the in person clinic being held Saturday May 4th 12:30-4:30pm
- ‘My First Pitch’ – Saturday May 4th – 4:30pm – All coaches are encouraged to take this course, even if you have taken it before. It is a great refresher on how to teach our players the proper pitching mechanics. For the Grand Slam coaches, we will have 11U players in attendance for you to use as a practice player. All 11U and 13U coaches, please bring your child with you to the course.

Rally Cap – Start date: Monday April 29th, practices every Monday and Wednesday 6:00-6:45pm, Location: 1st Soccer field by bleachers

Grand Slam – Start date: Monday April 29th, practices every Monday and Wednesday 6:00-7:00pm, Location: Diamond D (far left Diamond)

11U (Mosquito) – After pre-season, on field start date: Monday April 29th, practices every Monday and Wednesday 6:00-7:30pm, Locations: Diamond A, B & C – see emails from your coach or find your team on the website after April 20th.

13U (Peewee) – After pre-season, on field start date: Tuesday April 30th, practices every Tuesday and Thursday (time TBD by coach), Locations: Diamond B & C – see emails from your coach or find your team on the website after April 20th.

15U (Bantam) – After pre-season, on field start date: Monday April 29th, practices every Tuesday and Thursday 6:30-8:30pm, Locations: Diamond D

18U (Midget) – Season starts after high school baseball. For those players not playing high school ball, you can join the Bantams at their practice. Regular Midget practices: Monday and Wednesday 7:00-9:00pm, Locations: Diamond E
