#### BENCH STAFF BOND POSITIONS

- 7 Bond bench approved positions No split positions
  - 1 head coach
  - Up to 3 assistant coaches (only 5 members allowed on bench)
  - 1 trainer
  - 1 manager
  - Treasurer (Not required)
  - On ice helpers need to be on TRF for insurance purposes not bondable
  - Must be on TRF or a part of the association in another capacity to step on ice (player etc.)

## Registration

- All bench staff (including junior coaches) and on-ice assistants need to register as "a coach" via their RAMP account.
- On November 15 The registration system LOCKS. After this date, changes are only made with an ICF (Information Change Form). All player changes to teams require approval of the Regional Membership Services Coordinator. A/AA Teams also require approval from Competitions (G&T) Committee.
- Bench staff changes require the approval from RO Technical Director.
- After January 30 team changes are no longer allowed.

## Some Guidelines

- All coaches MUST use a proper ringette stick no sawed-off hockey sticks
- All regional teams will be supplied with home and away jerseys. We have worked hard to ensure every player gets matching numbers in their size.
- Any teams getting sponsors and/or fundraising, must provide a budget twice a year - December and in March
- All fundraising events must be approved by the DRA and will be voted on at a scheduled meeting
- The DRA meets the first Tuesday of the month any issues that you want brought forward will be discussed at the meetings unless it is an emergency.





- Goalies are a rare commodity in ringette
- Dorchester Ringette will be paying special attention to goalies this year and the coming years
- Every bench staff will require one on-ice coach to be dedicated to goalie development
- Goalie Clinics have been provided to all DRA goalies
- Any player who wants to be a goalie and needs assistance with equipment please let Christina know we will do our best to get them outfitted.

#### Coaching Assistance

- The DRA will be reaching out to all head coaches to ascertain what everyone needs.
- We recognize that each age group and each coach needs something different
- Coaches night 1 hour of in-person learning with Nicole Lindsay - 1.5 hour or on-ice drills and skills learning OCT 18th 630-9pm. This will count towards PD Points
- What this looks like is up to you folks- submit your learning needs to Gemma ASAP
- We value our coaches and the time you dedicate to this sport!



#### ICE SCHEDULE

- Mallory has worked hard to ensure consistent and fair ice for teams this year
- This will not always be perfect, but we are getting there
- IF YOU ARE NOT going to use your ice, please let Mallory know ASAP in the Whatsapp group. Ice is expensive! Our arena allows us to give ice back 24 hours prior (no other rink does this) but they prefer 72 hours.



#### **ICE SCHEDULE**

- If you are looking for ice during Christmas break please let us know ASAP. We lose our weekday ice because of the holidays.




#### **Blackout Ice**

- There are a couple of weekends where you can expect away games and no practices:

  - January 17-19 (BAD Girls Tournament)
  - Friday, January 31
  - February 27-March 2









#### **GLRL** (Provincial Play only)



 Please go to the GLRL website to ensure you understand this policy if you have not done so yet.



#### LORL (Regional play only)

- Rules are essentially the same as most have been adopted from WRRL.
- Female only teams U14-U19 were allowed to decide if they wanted to play against female teams or mixed teams. Remind your parents if you are playing against boys - THAT WAS THE TEAM'S CHOICE.
- When playing mixed teams 50% of the players on the ice for the mixed team must be female. U14-U19
- Anything related to fair play DOES NOT get reported to officials. Reach out to Mike or Shelley if you have a concern about a team.

#### **Penalties**

- Misconduct penalty results in an automatic one-game suspension.
- Match penalty results in an automatic two game suspension under RO rules (i.e. incurred at a tournament).
- 10 penalty minutes for one player in the same game results in an automatic one game suspension.
- 30 minutes in penalties by a team in a single game results in Coach expulsion and 1 game
- Major penalty reporting should be automated soon with the Gamesheets app.
- Major penalties must be reported to each league as well. Do this whether you are the offending team or the opponent.
- These are minimum outcomes, leagues and associations can add discipline.

## Sportsmanship

- Try to keep games within 7 goals
  - Rotate positions
  - 3 passes before a shot
  - Try to get resets (a U12+ skill)

- No scores kept or posted at U8
- No posting more than a 7-goal spread ever (all levels)
  - i. Change overall game score in 2nd tab if larger
- Prompt injury reporting is critical (within 10 days) & expect follow up
  - https://ringetteontario.com/content/sport-injury
- If you have a substitute player for a game you need to mark them as AP on the Gamesheet. A skater can only substitute 5 times for a specific team, but 8 games in total throughout the season (except goalkeepers unlimited). A player Substitution Form must be filled out on lorl.ca

## Reminders For Parent Meetings

- Review RO and Association Injury Policies
- Remind parents about RO <u>concussion policies</u> as concussion sheets are now completed during registration
- ALL athletes under 18 participating in ringette must have at least one parent/guardian that has completed the Respect in Sport for Parents on-line program by November 1st, or the players are suspended. This includes LTS/HL/FUN1 and FUN 2 programs.
- Remind parents that referee #'s are declining...be kind to the refs and keep family and friends under control
