- Registration Numbers as of Sept 11 @ 15:00
 - U7 = 50 (8 timbits)
 - U9 = 42
 - U11 = 52 (including the 2 in Leduc tryouts still); 9 goalies
 - U13 = 37 (including 2 in Leduc tryouts still; 4 goalies (1 of which is in Leduc)
 - U15 = 47 (including 5 in Leduc tryouts still; 5 goalies (1 of which is in Leduc)
 - U18 = 39 (2 transfers have been requested to Leduc so far); 6 goalies

Equipment Coordinator Dean Burghardt:

• Waiting to hear how many teams there will be to figure out jerseys.

League Representative Jen Winter:

- NEAHL league meeting Wed Sept 6th
- Need to register our teams by Oct 2 on the website, we will be sent invoices after registration
- Will be North, South, and West Pembina sub-divisions, DV teams could end up in different sub-div depending on numbers
- Pre-season scheduling will be done through Governor, will need to give 5 ie slots/team to Governor
- Regular season scheduling is done with managers and Dept. Governors over a couple of weeks. Ice slots are given to managers
- Re-tiering meeting is done night of Nov 7 in person with NEAHL executives, Governors and Dept Governors. Playoff format also decided this night
- Zero tolerance for ref abuse. Refs handle what happens on ice, but associations are responsible to handle issues in our facility with fans, consequences for league for situations not handled properly

- For U7/U9, there will be a form that teams can fill out voluntarily online to have your contact info available to aid scheduling games.
- Electronic games sheets + paper sheets until X-mas, then only electronic. Will need the RAMP app. Encourage all to practice with it online, videos to watch as well.
- NEAHL is encouraging leagues to put forward extra Dept Governors, will benefit your league

U7 Director Jared Wilkes:

• 4 U7 teams, 1 Timbits team.

U9 Director Ryan Hore:

- 4 teams
- Still reaching out to other communities to see how seasons will be ran. Only heard back from one team so far.
- NEAHL has space on website for entering U9 contact information to set up games.

U11 Director Evan Kluk:

- Thinking of moving to 3 teams instead of 4. 14 players for A, 15 for B, 16 for C. This instead of 11-12 per team.
- Do goalies attend player and goalie evaluations?

U13 Director Dean Lathwell:

- Would like to do 3 smaller teams rather than 2 bigger ones 'A' 10 skaters and goalie, 'B' 10 skaters and goalie, 'C' 12 skaters and goalie.
- Will reach out to U11 to see if any kids are interested in moving up to have better numbers for 3 teams.

U15 Director Katie Molzan:

- 3 teams
- Checking clinic new dates?
- Evaluations, is the plan from Matt so everyone is doing the same?
- If a player is trying out in Leduc and is in the second round, can they attend the conditioning skates here? They haven't paid dvmh fees as trying out in Leduc.

U18 Director Andrea Barrett:

• More players have joined U18 and hopefully can find a few more to solidify 2 teams. Sounds like a collaborative coaching staff for team 1.

- I do have one player that does not want to play games because of concussions and size etc but would like to apply as a junior coach and just practice with her brother's team. No games. Parents are happy to pay the full amount of registration (which I do believe they already have) just to have her practice only. Does anyone have a problem with this?
- Board does not have an issue with player being registered for hockey and practicing on the team. The player will have to be listed on the roster, but will be there with the understanding that they will not participate in games. Also, this player will be an extra spot on the roster and will not take the place of any other players trying out for the team.
