## 28th Annual Eastern Eagles Tournament Covid-19 Rules and Regulations

- Players and coaches of both teams make up a cohort, this cohort consists of 100 individuals per day. The field players and coaches are assigned to play on is their cohort.
- Spectators of two teams form their own cohort of 200 spectators will be directed to their assigned area and asked to stay 6m away from the field and others of different families.
- Teams and spectators playing or watching on fields 6 and 7, should park in the first parking lot off to the right just past the gate when driving into the facility.
- After games players, coaches, and spectators must leave the facility. You are not to mingle or mix between cohorts, but are allowed to go to the barbecue and canteen following the marked paths for crossing the complex and social distancing guidelines.
- Spectators and participants are allowed to access the barbeque and canteen before, during and after games which they are here for time at the facility.
- The game sheets are used as covid tracing sheets. Please inform coaches or managers who will be attending with the team.
- When crossing the facility to get to the washrooms, canteen, or barbeque, walk around the track or follow the arrows through the walking area to the right of the complex to not mix with other cohorts. Stay 6ft from others when in these areas.
- The canteen will be available through the outside window of the complex to limit the number of individuals inside the complex. Please line up along the ramp and stand 6ft apart when waiting in line, then exit down the stairs.
- A mobile canteen will also be going around to fields during games.
- When waiting in line at the barbeque stand at the marked spaces 6ft apart then follow the exit path.
- Porta potties are available around the complex, as well as a bathroom inside the complex. When using the washroom in the complex only one person or one family is allowed in the bathroom. Extra bathrooms are available in team rooms.
- Sanitizer will be distributed around the facility. Sanitize your hands before entering the complex.
- Anyone who is not abiding by covid-19 guidelines will be asked to leave the facility.
