The SEEBA organization provides an elite level of baseball that competes with other performance baseball teams in a provincial league. SEEBA is a baseball association that is highly committed to baseball excellence and expects the same from both players and parents. Commitment to the EXPOS winter workouts is strongly recommended in order to enhance your chances to be selected to play for one of the Edmonton EXPOS summer teams at the Midget, Bantam or PeeWee level. The winter workouts will be used to develop player skills and for the coaches to evaluate players for summer team selection at Midget, Bantam and Peewee levels.

All new and returning players email the completed player registration form and bring to the first session they attend. Don't wait to register because the workouts fill up quickly, enrollment will be capped. The first 80 registrants to reply will be accepted.

The Saturday workouts will be split allowing Mosquito and Pee Wee aged players their own time slot from 1100-1230Hrs. The Bantams and Midgets will practice separately from 1230-1400Hrs however we encourage the Midget aged players to arrive at 1200Hrs in order to allow them to warm up. The rationale for this is allow for more 'one on one' coaching opportunities for all participants.
