



Edmonton Ringette Club Code of Conduct

This code of conduct identifies the standard of behavior which is expected of the members of the Edmonton Ringette Club.

It applies to all ERC members while involved with activities as a member of the club. And includes athletes, team staff, the ERC representatives and parents.

At ERC sponsored events, all members will behave as representatives of the ERC. As such, members will conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike and responsible manner. Such conduct is expected during selection, practices, and at games, home and away. This includes tournaments and travel to these events.

The responsibilities of members are as follows:

In keeping with a sport environment, members must treat all individuals with respect.

- Members will refrain from comments or actions (including by any electronic means/social media) that are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. This includes interaction with volunteers, officials, or others involved with organizing the event, or the general public.
- Members will avoid any action that would disrupt or interfere with the preparation, the competition or the safety of any athlete.
- Team staff will conduct themselves professionally while teaching and coaching players. They will relate and interact in a manner which promotes self esteem, confidence, and personal growth in players. They will abide by the code of ethics as set out in the NCCP manual.
- Members shall observe ERC policies/guidelines, and all local laws.
