

Policies – Venue Rules

Section 5c

- 5c.1 The EYBA relies on facilities and schools to provide space for all games and practices. We must always respect the rules and policies of these venues, nothing less is acceptable.
- 5c.2 Vandalism
- 5c.2.1 Any Team, Coach, Manager, Responsible Adult, Player, Parent or Spectator found to have vandalized school or venue property will cause forfeiture of the game by the team associated with the person(s) concerned and may result in further disciplinary or legal action against the respective Team, Coaches, Manager, Responsible Adult, Players or Spectators.
- 5c.2.2 Additionally, the person(s) responsible shall receive an automatic FOUR (4) game suspension from EYBA play.
- 5c.2.3 The person(s) responsible will not be allowed to attend or participate in any EYBA sanctioned event until such time as they have provided a letter of apology. A copy must be submitted to the EYBA Executive Director.
- 5c.2.4 Progressive disciplinary action may be applied with repeat offenders.
- 5c.2.5 At the discretion of the EYBA, the individual concerned may be prohibited from EYBA activity until restitution of damages has been made.
- 5c.3 Relations with Venue Officials
- 5c.3.1 All Coaches, Managers, Responsible Adults, Players, Parents, Spectators and EYBA officials will show respect to and abide by requests made by any venue staff or venue officials.
- 5c.3.2 PENALTY: Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the game by the team associated with the incident and may result in further disciplinary action against the team, Coach(es), Manager, Responsible Adult, Parents, Spectator(s) or Official(s).
- 5c.4 Game/Indoor Shoes for All Participants and Spectators
- 5c.4.1 All venues used by EYBA require that Players and Coaches, Managers, Responsible Adults/Spectators, not be on the floor wearing outside shoes. Coaches, Managers, Responsible Adults/Spectators may wear socks or shoe covers.
- 5c.4.2 Any Player who does not have a pair of indoor shoes (a pair that has not been worn outside) will not be allowed to play. Failure to comply my cost EYBA the venue/school permanently.
- 5c.4.3 All Parents and Spectators and EYBA officials will remove outside footwear before entering a gymnasium. The footwear, once removed, must be left outside the gymnasium.
- 5c.4.4 PENALTY: Noncompliance will result in forfeiture of the game by the team associated with the individual and may result in further disciplinary action against the Team, Coaches, Managers, Responsible Adult, Players, Parents or Spectators.

5c.5 Use of Alcohol/Tobacco

5c.5.1 There will be no use of Alcohol or Tobacco by any person at any time in the venue or on the venue grounds while it is under the control of the EYBA.

5c.5.2 **PENALTY:** Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action by EYBA Discipline.

5c.6 Venue Housekeeping

5c.6.1 Each team must clean up their respective benches and vicinity at the end of the game to the condition in which they were found, or better.

5c.6.2 Players are to be given basketballs only in the gymnasium and are not to play with basketballs in hallways or surrounding areas.

5c.6.3 Food and drinks (other than water) are not permitted in the gymnasium for Coaches, Managers, Responsible Adults, Players, Parents or Spectators.

5c.6.4 Pets are not permitted.

5c.6.5 All Coaches, Managers, Responsible Adults, Players, Parents and Spectators are only permitted to be in the designated gymnasium we have rented. Classrooms, Offices, Hallways are off limits. Children are not to be left unattended.

5c.6.6 **PENALTY:** Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action against the Coach, Manager, Responsible Adult, who is responsible for the team at the time of the infraction by EYBA Discipline. This action is necessary to maintain our favorable relationship with the schools and other rented facilities.
