- 7e.1 We recommend all Spring League Teams familiarize themselves with the EYBA Rulebook.
- 7e.2 Unless otherwise listed below, all participants are to adhere to the EYBA Rulebook

7e.3 Modifications

- 7e.3.1 Four 9-minute quarters (stopped time) per game.
- 7e.3.2 All games will be played on 10-foot hoops and all teams will play 5 on 5.
- 7e.3.3 Wide key will be used (where available)
- 7e.3.4 18U is the ONLY division in which you may deploy all FIBA recognized defensive systems in both the front and back court.
- 7e.3.5 11U/13U/15U do NOT permit half court zone defense.
- 7e.3.6 There are NO Automatic Substitution Rules in 11U Spring League.

7e.4 Quick Reference

- 7e.4.1 EBOA officials will be used for all games.
- 7e.4.2 Each team is responsible to provide one minor official and one clean up official (Refer to Section 5a for responsibilities)
- 7e.4.3 Only players on the official team roster as of April 1 are allowed to play—no substitutions unless cleared by the league
- 7e.4.4 All team members must meet the age restrictions for their division of play. No overage players will be allowed.
- 7e.4.5 The league has the right to suspend any players or coach for any misconduct or inappropriate behavior (Refer to Sec. 11)
- 7e.4.6 Any inappropriate behaviour by fans/parents could result in immediate expulsion of the team from the league.
- 7e.4.7 All concerns or complaints should be addressed to the EYBA Executive Director to be then forwarded to EYBA Discipline.
- 7e.4.8 Any team that forfeits, or fails to show up for a playoff game, may be subject to a fine, up to a maximum of \$500.00.
