

Transferring Players

EYBA is made up of 11 Associations which cover Edmonton and the surrounding areas. Registrants are required to register for “Transfer Package” with their geographical association prior to release (Associations can be found in Section 3 of the Rulebook).

Transfer Process

- Each Association should create a “Transfer Package” in RAMP
 - o EYBA suggests that this package remain hidden, or password protected
 - o The password can be given if the transferring zone agrees to release the player AND the receiving agrees to accept the player.
 - o Email confirmation between zone directors is recommended
- Once a registrant has been approved and registered for a transfer package the player can then be transferred within RAMP’s registration services.

All transfer policies found in Section 3 of the EYBA Rulebook still apply – 3.17-3.31

Please note the addition of Section 3.32 Transfer Grandfathering Rule

3.32.1 All Import Players playing in Tier 4 or lower are not required to return to their geographical zone for the following season, they are considered part of their new zone if they remain in Tier 4 or lower.

3.32.2 All Import Players playing in Tier 1-3 are required to return to their geographical zone for the following season. These players must request a new release each season to ensure their geographical zone has enough players to field Tier 1-3 teams in each age category.

3.32.3 Any player looking to try out for a Tier 1-3 team must always register with their geographical zone first.

3.32.4 **Transfers that took place for the 2024-25 (or in a previous year) regular season (anyone that registered in the Fall of 2024 or before) can be considered grandfathered regardless of tier.

As per section 3.32.4 any player who played outside of their geographical zone is considered to be grandfathered and may remain with their current zone of play. Whether a proper transfer was completed to release them, or not.

Any new registrant effective June 20th, 2025, must adhere to the amended (3.32) transfer policies

Transfers are subject to each zone’s capacity and discretion. Zones are not obligated to accept transfers or release players

Any Transfers/Releases that take place outside of the aforementioned guidelines, may be subject to disciplinary action including, and not limited to, potential suspension and fines.
