

Edmonton Federation Hockey League Individual Player Accumulated Penalty Minute Suspensions

The following sanctions apply to ensure EFHL is consistent with all other leagues operating under the direction of Hockey Alberta.

DIVISION	SUSPENSION
U18	Once a player reaches 80 penalty minutes in
	total, they will receive a 1 game suspension
	and for every 25 minutes thereafter, the
	suspension will be doubled, (ie: 125=2, 150=4
	game suspension)
U15 Tier 1 BC	Once a player reaches 75 penalty minutes in
	total, will receive a 1 game suspension and for
	every 25 minutes thereafter the suspension is
	doubled. (see example above)
U15 Tier 2-3 BC and	Once a player reaches 65 penalty minutes in
Tier 1-3 NBC	total, will receive a 1 game suspension and for
	every 25 minutes thereafter the suspension is
	doubled. (see example above)
U13 Tier 1	Once a player reaches 60 penalty minutes in total
	will receive a 1 game suspension and for every 25
	minutes thereafter the suspension is
	doubled. (see example above)
U13 Tiers 2-6 and	Once a player reaches 50 penalty minutes in total
U11 Tier 1	will receive a 1 game suspension and for every 25
	minutes thereafter the suspension is
	doubled. (see example above)
U11 Tier 2-6	Once a player reaches 40 penalty minutes in
	total, will receive a 1 game suspension andfor
	every 25 minutes thereafter, the suspension
	will be doubled. (see example above)

^{*}Penalty minutes will not be accumulated from games while playing as an affiliate player; only penalties with the players registered team in league play and playoffs will be included in this total. Players who do not reach their first threshold during tiering and regular season will have their totals rest for playoffs. Players who reach threshold 1 during tiering and regular season will continue to accumulate and face discipline throughout the playoffs.

Game Sheet Management:

- It is imperative that game sheets are entered in a timely manner with the correct penalty minutes to ensure correct data when sanctioning players
- Division Directors have the ability to suspend coaches when game sheets are not entered in a timely manner (48 hours) or correctly to reflect all penalties
- Game sheet input will be spot checked by Division Directors and Category Directors to ensure accuracy of input
