

Game Cancellations Outside EIYSA Staff Office Hours (ie. Games cancelled after 4:00pm on Friday for Covid reasons ONLY due to insufficient players)

Covid Related Cancellations (ie. Players/Coaches with positive test results OR players/coaches showing symptoms)

- 1. Team experiencing Covid positive test results and/or symptoms related to Covid should contact the opposing team via phone.
- 2. Team experiencing Covid positive test results and/or symptoms related to Covid must also send an email to the opposing team. EIYSA office staff Dan Curtis (exdir@eiysa.com); Val Perry (admin@eiysa.com); and Cheryl Brodeur (admin2@eiysa.com) must be CC'ed on the email regarding the need to cancel. Game number, game time, game location must all be included in the email.
- 3. Team representative from team that is forced to cancel due to Covid reasons should show up for scheduled game time to inform referees of the situation.
- 4. The opposing team can use the scheduled game time for training purposes, should they choose to do so.

Team contacts can be found on the website by clicking the team's name and clicking the 'Staff' tab.

Travel to EIYSA League Games (For travel between Edmonton and Red Deer) - The home team must notify their opponent a minimum of 3 hours prior to kickoff to ensure travelling team has time to inform their players/parents that the trip is not necessary. Step #3 above does not apply to this scenario.

Dependent on facility availability EIYSA office will do their best to reschedule the game.
