INFRACTION PROCEDURES

Red / Yellow Cards

The Team Officials are responsible for maintaining records and tracking all players red and yellow card infractions and suspensions.

All violations shall be noted on the game sheet by the referee. Suspensions are automatic and team officers are responsible for heeding the suspensions, whether or not the office or the Commissioner has informed them.

Ejected and Suspended Individuals

Ejected persons shall immediately leave the field or building of play. This person shall not return to the field, building or locker room of the game until at least 45 minutes after the end of the said game. Leaving the field means being no closer than 250 meters from the nearest point of the field or building. (Rule 5.1.17)

Serving a Suspension

<u>Suspended Players</u> are required to sit separate from his/her team and may only be in the spectator area. The players may not dress in a team kit and are not allowed in the technical area or dressing rooms within 45 minutes before and after the scheduled game(s).

Players are suspended from all league play until suspension has been served in registration category. (The team they have registered with for the season.)

<u>Suspended Team Officials and Spectators</u> shall not attend any EIYSA games in the age category in which the suspension was issued, within forty five (45) minutes before and after the scheduled game(s).

Team official's suspensions are to be served from the category they received the suspension in. (Rule 5.1.18)

Suspensions occurred in league play can only be worked off in consecutive regularly schedules, completed league games.
