



## **Competition Rule for Indoor**

### **1. Spitting on an indoor field**

#### **Rule**

Any coach or non-playing personnel found spitting on the indoor field shall be removed from the field of play and its surrounds.

Any player or substitute found spitting on the playing surface must be sanctioned with a red card.

#### **Action and reporting**

- a. The Referee will note the name of the person and team affiliation of the person being removed with a notation “removed for spitting on the field.”
- b. The referee can play advantage for the opposing team if so warranted.
- c. Player is removed from the field and its surroundings, but the team is not reduced in numbers on the field (e.g. player can be replaced).
- d. The referee will note the name and number of the player/substitute on the Match Report with a notation “removed for spitting on the field.”
- e. Discipline: There is no further discipline than missing the game in which the removal occurred. However, EIYSA will track for repeat offenders and will work to proactively resolve any future occurrences.
