Hi Everyone - Hopefully you all enjoyed the Easter Long Weekend! I see a few people responded that they cannot attend on Thursday. Unfortunately, I can't do Wednesday and we really need to have a meeting.

Tracie was kind enough to arrange for the meeting room at Meridian Plaza, for Thursday @ 7pm. The address is: 10142 111 St

Attached you will find some important information. These items are on the agenda, as well as some other housekeeping. Please be sure you have read all of the info.

FENCING THE DUGOUTS

Grant has gotten 3 quotes for fencing in the dugouts. A little background to this:

As most people know, our homeless population adds a lot of work and COST to our organization. The garbage, the needles and drug paraphernalia, the graffiti and the human excrement needs to be cleaned out of the dugouts and other areas around the diamonds.

Another problem has arisen in that we have had several situations where weapons have been pulled on maintenance staff. The City has suggested we tear down the dugouts (we spent a lot of money to build these and Dennis had a quote of \$45 000 to remove them and fence the area in). This is not something most people want to do - we like having the shelter from the weather. We do need to do something to keep people safe, discourage our over night guests and cut down on our clean up costs.

Fencing and locking the dugouts seems a more reasonable compromise. We do have the money in our contingency fund and hope to see if the city might have a grant or other money we could access for assistance (big HOPE).

We have options in terms of how many dugouts we fence/secure. However, not doing things all at once will significantly increase costs. If we also fence the picnic area, this helps with the liquor permit. THIS IS TIME SENSITIVE. Please read the quotes and share your thoughts at or before the meeting - especially if you cannot attend.

HIRING MAINTENANCE CREW

We also need to hire some maintenance workers. It is very important that these people have the skills/background to perform the necessary tasks, but most importantly the fitness and the personality to work together and be able to deal with potential situations as they arise. We will need to have open conversations with the applicants about the current homeless situation and how best to handle things so that there are no dangerous confrontations.

We also need to be sure that the new crew can fill out detailed time sheets, understand that they report to the board (until we have a director of maintenance) and are doing tasks that the board has directed. I have attached info about the current applicants.

Our plan is to have Richard be more of a consultant, going forward. Rick, Dennis and Jaime have resigned but the first two are going to help us get under way and mentor our new maintenance crew to get things up and running. Thankfully, Grant has been assisting with much of this, as he was our Maintenance Director in the past.

If you have any insight that will assist us in choosing the best people for the job, please share.

CLEAN UP

We need to do a full facility clean up. The season is fast approaching. Also, if we are going ahead with fencing this will need to be done prior to the work starting. I would like to have our first clean up on Sunday April 16th at 2pm.

We need to have someone there to supervise the signing in of volunteers, so we can arrange for the return of the \$25 for these individuals. We need to advertise this asap- they should respond to info@esspa.ca if they are signing up to do their 2 hour committment. They should wear thick soled, closed toe footwear and heavy gloves.

TREASURER

Barb has found us a treasurer!

Medley Russell is an accountant for the province, so she has more than enough experience!

She is registered with WFC in the Women's Division. We need to make a motion to have her take over the treasurer duties before we burn out M.E.!

RADIO SPOT

FYI Brent and I are doing a radio spot on Friday night promoting the league.

EVALUATION FORMAT/DATES etc.

We have some people working on the format of evaluations. We will need a list of names and contact emails, of the new contestants, so we can let them know the evaluation dates and/or contact them if the weather causes issues.

REGISTRANT LISTS for DIVISION COORDINATORS

Divison co-ordinators will need the names of registrants so they can be cross referenced. We want people to be happy and should confirm that people registered where they intended.
