Youth Volunteer Police Check Application Process

Thank you for choosing to volunteer with the EUPA Youth Program. To ensure the safety of all youth participants, a **Vulnerable Sector Police Check** is required for all adult volunteers and staff working with youth.

This document will guide you through the steps involved in obtaining a police check and outline the available options. Our goal is to keep the process simple and provide clear guidance.

Please note: Police checks can take up to **15 business days** to process. Be sure to allow sufficient time to receive your check.
