

GEMSA Policy/Procedure Scholarship Review & Awarding



- **All Scholarship Applications received by June 30th of the Current Playing Season are to be reviewed and presented to voting board members.**
- **3 - \$1000 scholarships are to be awarded and held in trust until the recipient submits further education receipts and/or outline.**
- **All U17 and U19 players are welcome to Submit an application.**
 - All Applications will be sent to a designated board member. This board member will do the presentation of the Applications, but not have a vote or final say in the decisions.
 - The Designated board member(s) will redact all personal identifiers from the applications to ensure that anonymity is kept and voting board members will not be biased based on personal player knowledge.
 - Any board members who do NOT have applicants and are not the board member designated to receive the application will have a vote.
 - In the event of a tied vote, or if the board cannot come to an agreement on the selection of the recipients, an outside party will be brought in to review and assist in the decision making process. This person may be.
 - Umpire in Chief (or designate) from BRUA/EBC/ASUA
 - Past President/Commissioner
 - Softball Alberta Designated Representative
