GEMSA Finals Tournament Rules

GEMSA Finals Specific Rules:

(The following rules are for the GEMSA Finals Only)

- Time limits/ Innings:
 - No new innings after 1 hour and 30mins for Bracket Play
 - No new innings after **2 hours for Medal games**
 - Games will have a 7 inning max, unless tied. (If games are tied after the expiration
 of Time Limit or 7 completed innings. Games will proceed with the international tiebreaker rule in effect)
- Mercy Rules:
 - 15 runs or more after 3 completed innings.
 - 10 runs or more after 4 completed innings.
 - **7 Runs or more** after 5 completed innings/
 - The losing team may, at any time, concede the game by informing the umpire that the game is conceded.
 - (note: The full inning must be completed prior to the game be conceded)

Rules:

- Games will be played under Softball Canada Rules unless otherwise stated.
- There will be 7 run rule max per half inning.
- Unlimited Defensive Substitutions. Teams can choose to bat their whole lineup or bat a "Starting 9" (this must be declared to the Home Plate Umpire prior to the game)
- If teams begin the game with "Starting 9 batting order" you can not change batting order format (Change to full team batting) Offensive Substitutions rules will be in effect.

Equipment:

- Metal Cleats will be allowed during game play.
- Facemasks are recommended for all infielders but are not mandatory during gameplay.
- Pitcher must wear an approved facemask during gameplay.
- Only approved bats by Softball Canada will be allowed.
