GEMSA Opening Weekend Rules:

(The following rules are for the GEMSA Opening Weekend)

- Time limits/ Innings:
 - No new innings after 1 hour and 30mins
 - Games will have a 7-inning max (Ties will be counted)
 - Time limit will start at the end of the Plate Talk (Both teams need to be ready to go)
- Mercy Rules: Run ahead rule
 - 20 after 4 innings
 - 15 after 5 innings

Rules:

- Games will be played under Softball Canada Rules unless otherwise stated.
- There will be **7 run rule max** per half inning.
- Unlimited Defensive Substitutions. All players on the lineup card Bat.
- Home teams will supply 3 approved Softball Canada Game Ready Balls for the game. (Slo-Pitch Balls are not allowed)

Equipment:

- For U15, and U17/19 Metal Cleats will be allowed during game play.
- Facemask are mandatory during gameplay for all infielders as per Softball Alberta.
- Pitcher must wear an approved facemask during gameplay.
- Only approved bats by Softball Canada will be allowed.

GEMSA Weekday Games:

- Time Limits/ Innings: Games are completed when one of the 2 occurs
 - No new innings after 1 hour and 50 minx
 - Completed 7-innings (Ties will be counted)
- Mercy Rules:
- There are No mercy rules in effect for weekday games.

Rules:

- Games will be played under Softball Canada Rules unless otherwise stated.
- There will be 7 run rule max per half inning.
- Unlimited Defensive Substitutions. All players on the lineup card Bat.
- Home teams will supply 3 approved Softball Canada Game Ready Balls for the game. (Slo-Pitch Balls are not allowed)

Equipment:

- For U15, and U17/19 Metal Cleats will be allowed during game play.
- Facemask are mandatory during gameplay for all infielders as per Softball Alberta.
- Pitcher must wear an approved facemask during gameplay.
- Only approved bats by Softball Canada will be allowed.

2025 Pick Up Rules: (Competitive Division Only)

- Once Roster is finalized no new players will be allowed to be added to your roster. (Note: You can only pick up
 players if your team is going to have 9 players or less for a game. A maximum of 10 players will be allowed
 on the lineup card)
- Players must be marked on the lineup card with an (AF) on the lineup prior to the start of the game.
- Teams in the Competitive Division for the 2025 season will be allowed to pick up players from
 - 1. Teams in the Rec Division in the same age category (i.e. U15 teams can pick up from U15 rec and below)
 - 2. Teams can request pickups from teams in the same division (i.e. U17/19 can pick up from other U17/19 teams)

(BEFORE this occurs the team looking to pick up must EMAIL and have approval (email or text approval) from the Pick-Up players Head Coach and a copy of that approval must be emailed to admin@gemsa.ca Prior to the start of the game.)

• If a team is caught using a Non-GEMSA registered/approved player, the team will forfeit the game, and the Head Coach will be suspended for **2 games**.
