FC Regina Adult Tournament

When & Where

The tournament will run September 25 to 27, 2025 at the Affinity Plex in Regina SK. Teams playing on Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday will not play until 6:00PM or later. Games may start as early as 8:00 AM on Saturday. The tournament will wrap up on Saturday and have games starting as late as 11:00 PM.

Format Overview

- 6v6 Games (5 outfield + 1 keeper)
- Quarter field turf
- Single Elimination Style with Relegation Pools
- Men's Open Division, Women's Open Division, and Coed Open Division
- All teams start in the Main Bracket

- All teams are guaranteed a minimum of three matches, with relegation pools and placement games ensuring continued play.
- After each loss, teams drop to a new pool with increased access to Secret Weapons

Team & Player Registration

Team registration will be online only. Online registration will be available using the tournament link on the FC Regina (FCR) website (www.fcregina.com). Please select the team registration tab. Teams are required to submit their registration and fees September 10. Only registrations submitted with the required information and fees will be considered complete.

All players must be registered with their local District/Provincial Association. Players must be 15 years of age by the roster deadline to be eligible to play. Team status forms are required from all Saskatchewan teams (excluding FCR teams) by September 22 midnight. Final rosters will be due on September 22 at midnight. Travel permits are required from all out of province teams by September 22 midnight.

Team Roster

Rosters must be submitted online by the deadline of September 22. Any roster changes or additions must be approved by the Tournament Committee. No roster changes or additions will be made once the tournament begins. Youth status players are not eligible to participate in this tournament.

- Men's Division: min 12 players max 16
- Women's Division: min 12 players max 16
- Coed Division: min 12 players max 16, at least 2 players of the opposite gender must always be on the field. The goalkeeper is exempt from this rule.

Registration Fees:

- Registration Fees (3 games guaranteed)
- Men's Division: \$650.00
- Women's Division: \$650.00
- Coed Division: \$650.00

Tournament Brackets

MAIN BRACKET (Winner's Pool)

- All teams start here
- 1 secret weapon per game per team
- If you lose, you drop to the Chaos Pool
- Cash prize

CHAOS POOL (Second Chance Pool)

- Teams who have lost once
- 2 secret weapons per game per team
- Lose again, and you're sent to the Final Mayhem Pool
- Cash prize

FINAL MAYHEM POOL (Last Chance Madness)

- Teams with 2 losses
- Up to 3 secret weapons per game per team (determined by dice roll, each team will roll to see how many secret weapons up to a max of 3)
- Last team standing wins the "Mayhem Cup" or a fun consolation prize

Game Procedures

- Game Time: 2 x 20-minute halves (5-minute halftime)
- Unlimited rolling subs
- If tied: 1v1 running penalty shootout (best of 3, then sudden death)
- Game sheets (rosters) will be prepared in advance by the Tournament Committee and must be reviewed and signed by a team official at least 15 minutes prior to each game.
- FC Regina will supply the game balls.
- Teams are to have two sets of Jerseys. Pinnies/Bibs are acceptable as the second set as long as they have numbers and are a different color.
- Teams are to declare their Home and Away jersey colors at time of registration. If there is a color conflict home team will be required to change.
- If Away team wears a color that is not what they declared and there is a color conflict Away will be required to change. We will share a link to the document for the Uniform Declarations so teams can check Jersey colors prior to their game.
- All games will be played on marked turf fields with metal structure nets.
- There will be no offsides.
- All other FIFA laws of the game are applied.
- Secret weapons are drawn before kickoff and used tactically during the match.
- Secret weapons must be presented to the referee during game stoppage to be used.
- Once a secret weapon expires once they have been used.

Secret Weapons

Weapon Name	Effect
1. 🎯 Instant Penalty	Take a penalty kick at any moment
2. 👤 Extra Player (2 min)	Play with 1 extra outfield player for 2 minutes
3. 🍷 Double Goals (2 min)	Goals count as 2 for 2 minutes
4. ⚡ Power Play (2 min)	Opponents must play with 2 less players on the field for 2 minutes

5. 🧤 Goalie Swap	Both teams must swap their GK immediately for 4 min
6. 🎲 Mystery Card	Draw a random effect (new rule tournament host creates for the day)

- Secret weapons are drawn before kickoff and used tactically during the match
- Secret weapons can only be used during regular playing time.
- The number of secret weapons is determined by the pool in which the team is playing in.

Game Tiebreakers

Each game must end in a win. If a game ends in a tie:

- Best-of-3 1v1 running penalties
 - Ball starts at midfield, and the player has 5 seconds to score
 - The keeper must stay on the goal line until the player touches the ball and then can advance.

Emergency Protocol

There will be FC Regina staff members available with First Aid and CPR training. Report all injuries to FC Regina facility staff members and complete an injury report form.

Discipline & Protests

While this tournament features fun twists and chaos driven gameplay, it is still governed by respect for the game, officials, opponents, and fans. All players are expected to compete with integrity and maintain a positive atmosphere.

Discipline Rules:

- **Yellow Card** = 2-minute sin bin (team plays short for 2 minutes) Player is eligible to return at the first stoppage of play once the 2 minutes have expired.
- **Red Card** = Player is ejected from the match and the team must play short for 4 minutes. A player is eligible to return at the first stoppage of play once the 4 minutes have expired, the ejected player is not eligible to return and must leave the field of play.
- Persistent misconduct, violent behavior, or abuse toward referees, opponents, tournament committee, or fans may result in suspension from the tournament.

This tournament is designed to be a fun, social, and inclusive event. Teams are reminded that while competition is encouraged, sportsmanship and enjoyment take priority. The goal

is to create memorable moments, meet new people, and embrace the playful chaos not to take home a trophy at all costs.

Protest Procedures:

Protests will not be heard on a judgment call by a Referee. Protests will be heard on eligibility or technical matters provided they are in writing and submitted to the Tournament Committee within 30 minutes of the completion of the game in question. The protest must be accompanied by a \$125 fee and signed off by the team manager. If the protest is upheld the \$125 will be refunded.

Refund & Cancellation Policy

If your team must withdraw, please contact FC Regina at 306-352-8040 or adult@fcregina.com immediately. Teams that withdraw or cancel after the team registration deadline will forfeit their entire entry fee.

If a division is not viable after the team registration deadline, applicable teams will be refunded their team registration fee.
