



FC REGINA BLUESTARS OVERVIEW

All registered FC Regina players will be assigned to individual team rosters for the indoor season. They will participate with their teams for designated weekly training, FCR Youth league games ,and tournament play (TBD).

The FCR BlueStars program provides an opportunity to the top performing players to compete in the **Provincial Soccer League** (**PSL**), or various high-level competitions determined by the FC Regina Technical Staff.

Over the course of the season, regular team play will also be supplemented by the FCR BlueStars selects programming. Player assessment will be ongoing throughout the indoor season and will be determined by player performance, attitude and behaviour on and off the field during all games and training.

Recommendations for player selection will be suggested by FCR coaches and technical staff

Not all players will be selected for BlueStars events throughout the course of any season, but we will continue to assess player performance and consult with the coaching staff on a regular basis. Our intention is to provide all players a fair and justified opportunity to play at their highest potential within the club.

The FCR BlueStars program will provide an opportunity to the top performing players assessed during the indoor season to compete in the outdoor **Provincial Soccer League (PSL)**, or various high-level competitions determined by the FC Regina Technical Staff. U15 and U17 Players assigned to BlueStars teams for outdoor will participate only in BlueStars programming unless otherwise stated by the FC Regina Technical Staff.

From the perspective of player development, this is an ideal situation for players that is in line with the "Long-Term Player Development" (LTPD) and excellence standards established by the Canadian Soccer Association.

Parents and athletes will be provided with an estimate of costs in advance of all BlueStars programming and events.



The Premier Soccer League (PSL), operated by the Saskatchewan Soccer Association (SSA), is a province-wide competition and represents the highest level of play currently available in Saskatchewan.

PSL is open to representative teams from SSA Member Organizations and entities in Male and Female Under U13 Development, U15 and U17 divisions



FCR Team selections will be based on confirmed player registration for FCR Premier. Player selection will be based on performance throughout the previous indoor season. Recommendations will be accepted from FCR Technical staff, FCR individual team coaching staff and designated PSL coaching staff.



Participation in the PSL aligns with Canada Soccer's Pathway and Long-Term Player Development model (Training to Train and Training to Compete Stages) and provides the following advantages:

- Structured and high-quality training environment focused on technical, physical and mental components of the sport
- Access to a high-performance league and challenging competition
- Identification opportunities for regional excellence centers and academies



SEASON

The PSL season begins in May and concludes in July with the PSL Finals for the U15 and U17 age groups, along with a separate final festival event for the U13 age divisions.

Training/Additional Programming

Training sessions will be arranged through FC Regina and confirmed with team staff. All players to arrive at training no later than 15 minutes prior to the designated start time.

Games

Teams should be prepared to play on weekdays and all weekends from May-July. The number of team entries will determine the number of regular season games which could range from 3-6+. The PSL Final location is TBD . All players to arrive at games no later than 60 minutes prior to kick-off, unless otherwise stated by the team staff.

Travel

All players to travel/arrive in official FC Regina attire. ALL players and staff only to travel by bus together. Teams should look for opportunities where two teams can share bus transportation.

Accommodations

U13 - TBD by team

U15-U17 players only to share rooms of a maximum of 2 players per room or 1 player per bed.

Team Fees:

Team fees are in addition to registration fees and will be set at the start of the season by the team staff and collected by the team manager and/or team treasurer. Team fees can range from \$500 upwards depending on the age/division and events the team has planned and/or entered.

Team fees may include (but are not limited to) the cost for items such as:

- Tournament entry fees
- Team Apparel (See additional page for required BlueStars apparel)
- Team Personnel (up to 4 Staff) expenses for out-of-town travel for tournaments and events
- Team pictures, team windup, and other items
- Bus transportation
- Player accommodations


