## Entry and Exit Safety Plan

Everyone will enter at the AffinityPlex Main Entrance only. Must only enter the AffinityPlex 15 minutes prior to your scheduled event.

Youth players, coaches and managers will sanitize their hands then show their signed declaration at check in station. Staff will mark attendance for contact tracing. They must wear a mask upon entrance of the building and with the exception of players, it must remain on for the duration of the stay at the AffinityPlex. Players must wear a mask until they enter the field, where it will be placed into a Ziploc bag. Before leaving the field, players must put their mask back on until they leave the building.

Adult Players will sanitize their hands then sign their declaration form at the check in station. This will be kept for contact tracing. Players must wear a mask until they enter the field, where it will be placed into a Ziploc bag. Before leaving the field, players must put their mask back on until they leave the building.

Staff, and referees will sanitize then sign in and sign out. Staff will wear a mask at all times. Referees will wear a mask until they get to the field. Only referees who are not involved in any other mini league will be allowed to ref without a mask. (This includes if they are reffing in multiple leagues, if they are playing, or if they are coaching).

Spectators will sanitize then sign in providing their printed first and last name, and their phone number. This will be logged with the roster for the game they are coming to watch as we have implemented a one spectator per athlete rule. Spectators will be required to wear a mask for the entire time they are in the facility. There will be no exceptions.

Players, coaches, managers, and referees will enter the dressing room area from the entrance beside the Subway. Masks must remain on at all times. Players will be directed by FC Regina staff when the facility has been cleared/sanitized and is ready for them to come out through the "Washroom" entrance. They will return to the dressing rooms through the "Washroom" entrance and back to their dressing rooms.

Spectators will be required to go into the facility using the entrance directly in front of the facility front desk. Spectators will be required to exit from the North end of the facility through the Exits there. This is to avoid congestion with the next group that will be entering. Spectators must be removed from the facility immediately following the game they have come to watch. Spectators will not be allowed in for the next game until the facility has been cleared.
