The FCR BlueStars program provides an opportunity for the top performing U11 to U19 players to compete in special event-based programing and access to additional training opportunities throughout the year. These training and competition opportunities will help the technical staff to evaluate and prepare players for potential selection to represent FC Regina in the SSA Prairie Soccer League (PSL)





The Prairie Soccer League (PSL), operated by the Saskatchewan Soccer Association (SSA), and is provincewide competition and represents the highest level of play currently available in Saskatchewan. Open to representative teams from SSA Member Organizations and Entities in Male and Female Under U13 Development, U15 and U17 divisions.



# **PLAYER ASSESMENT / SELECTION PROCESS**

#### INDOOR BLUESTARS PROGRMING (EVENT BASED)

Player assessments are ongoing throughout the indoor / outdoor season and recommendations are made in collaboration with Coaches and Technical Staff based on performance in training and competition. Rosters may vary from event to event and not all division 1 players will be guaranteed selection to project. Player invitations will be sent out by Technical Staff via email with a target of a minimum 14 days prior to each event.

#### OUTDOOR BLUESTARS PROGRAMING (PSL)

PSL player selections will be based on performance throughout the previous indoor season. Recommendations will be accepted from FCR Technical staff, FCR Individual Team coaching staff and designated PSL Coaching staff.

- U11 Programing will continue to be event based, pending on competition and scheduling availability.
- PSL Rosters for U13 are flexible and subject to change based on player performance and availability to be in line with Canada Soccer's Grassroots Standards.
- PSL Rosters for U15 and U17 will be finalized no later than 30 days prior to the official start of the season.

# **BLUESTARS TRAVEL GUIDELINES**

Team fees are in addition to regular FCR registration fees and will be set at the start of the season by the team staff and collected by the team manager and/or team treasurer. Team fees can range from \$50 to upwards of \$1000.00 depending on the age/division and events the team has planned and/or entered.

Team fees may include (but are not limited to) the cost for items such as:

- Tournament entry fees
- Team Personnel (up to 4 Staff) expenses for out-of-town travel for tournaments and events
- Team Apparel (Tracksuits / Backpacks)
