Installment Payments:

Online Registration provides you the option of setting up installment payments on your credit card only. If you need to set up alternate payment arrangements, please contact the Executive Director at tjsingh@fcregina.com

Referral Program:

If you refer a new member and they put your name on their registration you will receive \$25.00 in Club Credits to be used towards any FCR programming or FCR clothing. To be considered a new member – they have never registered with FCR or haven't registered with FCR in the past 5 years.

Family – Multi-Player Discount:

Families who have multiple youth registered will be given a discount on registration as follows:

- 1st youth registered will receive no discount.
- 2nd youth registered will receive a \$25.00 discount.
- 3rd, and subsequent youth registered will receive a \$35.00 discount each on registration.

****all youth registrants must be from the same family and living in the same house in order to receive the discount****

MOJO APP:

This app will be used by FC Regina for communicating with all youth members. Teams will also be able to use this as their team app for communicating with their teams. Teams will no longer be using TeamLinkt or Team snap or any other app other than MOJO.

Home Team Live:

Live streaming of FC Regina hosted events. Multiple athlete families – Pay once, you will need to email Rhandi at execassist@fcregina.com in order to be refunded for players registered above 1.

This will be shareable with your family. This App will be available on your Tablet, smartphone, desktop, and smart TV. Requests can be made for a recording of a game for player highlights for college/university recruitment. Only new players and players who did not play indoor will be required to purchase this package.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Teams will be formed based on the number of certified coaches registered. If you register late there is no guarantee that there will be a place for your child on a team. Last day to register is April 2nd, 2024, or until the program is full. Starting April 3rd, 2024, or when the program is full individuals will be put on a waitlist. There will be a \$50.00 late registration fee for those registering after April 2nd, 2024.

Please make every effort to ensure you register your child on time.

Early Bird Draw will take place on March 9th, 2024. Must be registered by the end of day March 8th, 2024. To be eligible for the Early Bird Draw, payments must be made in full or if doing automatic installments 1st payment must be made. Players applying for funding through KidSport, Jumpstart, or Dream Brokers and are awaiting funding approval will be included in the draw. 1st place will be \$500.00 in FCR Club Credits, 2nd place will be \$300.00 in FCR Club Credits, and 3rd place will be \$200.00 in FCR Club Credits.

League Format:

FC Regina will be presenting an outdoor league format for U9 to U17 consisting of weekday training and league games on the weekends. Youth teams playing in adult league could have games during the week. **Youth U13 and up Playoffs TBD.** U9 and U11 will have a Jamboree/Festival style wrap up to their season date TBD. Designated field time for training, start and end date is TBD.

Division 2 Skills Academy:

For Division 2 players wanting additional training sessions, make sure to register for the Division 2 Skills Academy, which will be a package available during the registration process. 9 sessions. Dates: TBD. Cost: U13 Division 2 - \$203.00, U15 Division 2 - \$224.00, U17 Division 2 - \$235.20.

Player Cards:

U9 up to U17 may need player cards for non-FCR tournaments, provincials, and PSL. Players are required to upload a picture (headshot) when registering. Teams playing in adult league or players playing as a call up player in adult league will need a player card. If the player card is lost, replacement cards are available at a cost of \$10. Managers are to contact FCR Youth Coordinator (youth@fcregina.com) 2 weeks prior to tournament/provincial start date, if player cards are required, to have the teams' player cards processed. The FCR Youth Coordinator will contact the team manager when the player cards are done. Team player/staff status forms may be done in lieu of Player cards for tournaments.

Player Evaluation and Selection Process:

FC Regina players will be continually evaluated and assessed through ongoing training and match play. These evaluations and assessments will be used to make player selections for the upcoming season. Details and dates regarding Player evaluation sessions will be posted on the website www.fcregina.com.

Team Fees:

Team fees are in addition to registration fees and will be set at the start of the season by the team and collected by the team manager and/or team treasurer. Team fees can range from \$50 to upwards of \$1000.00 depending on the age/division and events the team has planned and/or entered. Team fees may include (but are not limited to) the cost for items such as:

- ✿ Tournament entry fees
- ✿ Team Personnel expenses for out-of-town travel for tournaments/PSL
- ✿ Team pictures & windup
- ✿ Other items

Game Kits:

New players in U9 and up or players who did not play in the indoor season will need to purchase their game kits at time of registration. Game kits will consist of 2 game jerseys (Home/Away, Grey/Pink), 1 pair of Game shorts (light blue), and 1 pair of Game socks (Pink socks). The cost of the game kit is \$125.00. Light Blue Game socks, \$15.00 are a requirement if you don't already have them. Replacement shorts/socks can be purchased through the Uniform Committee at uniforms@fcregina.com cost is for individual items.



Training Kits:

If you are a New Player to FC Regina you will need to purchase a Training Kit (1 t-shirt, 1 pair of shorts and 1 pair of socks) cost is for individual items. White training Shirt \$17.00, Black Training shorts \$19.00, White Training socks \$12.00. Players requiring replacement items can contact the Uniform Committee at uniforms@fcregina.com . Proper footwear and shin guards are mandatory equipment and are the players/parents' responsibility to purchase. All players should have their own water bottle.



Volunteer Bond:

A \$100 volunteer bond cheque for U9 and up, post-dated to Aug. 1st, 2024, payable to FCR will be collected by the team manager. You are required to volunteer 1 shift per player to a maximum of 3 players. A large number of volunteers are required in order to deliver our soccer programs. Failure to meet your volunteer commitment by the end of the season will result in the cheque being cashed. **Any bond cheques that are cashed and returned will be subject to a \$25.00 NSF charge. If you have no intention of volunteering your time, please choose the buyout option when registering online.** The volunteer commitment can be satisfied by:

Team Level

- Coach of any age division – covers all children in family
- Assistant Coach of any age division – covers all children in family
- Manager of any age division – covers all children in family
- Treasurer – covers one child
- Gender Rep – covers one child

Club Level

- Committee Member – covers all children in family
- Tournament volunteer worker – covers one child
- Evaluations – covers one child
- Equipment Distribution – covers one child
- Equipment Collection – covers one child

Board Level

- Board Member – covers all children in family
- Board Committee Member – covers all children in family
