Installment Payments: Online Registration provides you the option of setting up installment payments on your credit card.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Teams will be formed based on number of certified coaches registered. If you register late there is no guarantee that there will be a place for your child on a team. Last day to register is April 18th, 2021 or until program is full. Starting April 19th, 2021 or when program is full individuals will be waitlisted.

Please make every effort to ensure you register your child on time.

League Format: FC Regina will be presenting an outdoor league format for U9 to U19 consisting of weekday training and league games on the weekends. Youth teams playing in Adult league could have games during the week. **Youth Playoffs will start July 3rd and be completed by July 11th.** Designated field time for training, start and end date is TBD.

Player Cards: U9 up to and including U19 players need player cards for non-FCR tournaments, PSL and Provincials. Players new to FC Regina can send a head shot into Norma at youth@fcregina.com with players' name and age group (i.e.: John Doe U13 Boys). If the player card is lost, replacement cards are available at a cost of \$10. Managers are to contact FCR Youth Coordinator (youth@fcregina.com) 2 weeks prior to tournament/provincial start date to have the teams' player cards processed.

Player Evaluation and Selection Process: FC Regina players will be continually evaluated and assessed through ongoing training and match play. These evaluations and assessments will be used to make player selections for the

upcoming season. Details and dates regarding Player evaluation sessions will be posted on the website www.fcregina.com.

Team Fees: Team fees are in addition to registration fees and will be set at the start of the season by the team and collected by the team manager and/or team treasurer. Team fees can range from \$50 to upwards of \$1000.00 depending on the age/division and events the team has planned and/or entered. Team fees may include (but are not limited to) the cost for items such as:

- 🔑 Tournament entry fees
- 🔑 Team Personnel expenses for out-of-town travel for tournaments/PSL
- 🔑 Team pictures & windup
- 🔑 Other items

Uniforms: Players U9 and up will be supplied with 2 club jerseys. These jerseys are to be handed in to your team manager at the end of the season. If you are a New Player to FC Regina you will need to purchase a Training Kit (1 t-shirt, 1 pair of shorts and 1 pair of socks), cost is for individual items. New Players to FC Regina will also need to purchase a Game Kit (game shorts & game socks), cost is for individual items. New Players requiring the Training or Game Kit will need to contact the Uniform Committee at fcruniforms@gmail.com. Replacement items are available for all members and cost will be for individual items. Players requiring replacement items can contact the Uniform Committee at fcruniforms@gmail.com. Proper footwear and shin guards are mandatory equipment and are the players/parents' responsibility to purchase. All players should have their own water bottle.

Jersey Deposit: **A \$100 uniform deposit cheque for U9 and up, post-dated to Aug. 1st, 2021, payable to FCR will be collected by the team manager.** Players will not be provided with jerseys until the jersey deposit cheque is received. These cheques will be destroyed at the end of the season if the jerseys are returned. If the jerseys are not returned, or have been damaged (stained, torn) beyond regular wear-and-tear, the jersey deposit cheque will be cashed. **Any deposit cheques that are cashed and returned will be subject to a \$25.00 NSF charge.**

Volunteer Bond: **A \$100 volunteer bond cheque for U9 and up, post-dated to Aug. 1st, 2021, payable to FCR will be collected by the team manager.** You are required to volunteer 1 shift per player to a maximum of 3 players. A large number of volunteers are required in order to deliver our soccer programs. Failure to meet your volunteer commitment by the end of the season will result in the cheque being cashed. **Any bond cheques that are cashed and returned will be subject to a \$25.00 NSF charge. If you have no intention of volunteering your time, please choose the buyout option when registering online.**
