#### **Installment Payments:**

Online Registration provides you the option of setting up installment payments on your credit card only. If you need to set up alternate payment arrangements, please contact the Executive Director at <u>tjsingh@fcregina.com</u>

#### **Referral Program:**

If you refer a new member and they put your name on their registration you will receive \$25.00 in Club Credits to be used towards any FCR programming or FCR clothing. To be considered a new member – they have never registered with FCR or haven't registered with FCR in the past 5 years.

#### Family – Multi-Player Discount:

Families who have multiple youth registered will be given a discount on registration as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> youth registered will receive no discount
- 2<sup>nd</sup> youth registered will receive a \$25.00 discount
- 3<sup>rd</sup>, and subsequent youth will receive a \$35.00 discount each on registration

## \*\*all youth registrants must be from the same family and living in the same house in order to receive the discount\*\*

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE**:

Teams will be formed based on number of certified coaches registered. If you register late there is no guarantee that there will be a place for your child on a team. Last day to register is April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, or until program is full. Starting April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022, or when program is full individuals will be put on a waitlist. There will be a \$50.00 late registration fee for those registering after April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022.

Please make every effort to ensure you register your child on time.

### Early Bird Draw will take place on March 10th, 2022. 1st place will be \$500.00 in FCR Club Credits, 2nd place will be \$300.00 in FCR Club Credits, and 3rd place will be \$200.00 in FCR Club Credits.

#### League Format:

FC Regina will be presenting an outdoor league format for U9 to U19 consisting of weekday training and league games on the weekends. Youth teams playing in adult league could have games during the week. Youth U13 and up Playoffs will start July 3<sup>rd</sup> and be completed by July 11<sup>th</sup>. U9 and U11 will have a Jamboree/Festival style wrap up to their season. Designated field time for training, start and end date is TBD.

#### **Player Cards:**

U9 up to and including U19 players may need player cards for non-FCR tournaments, provincials, and PSL. Players are required to upload a picture (headshot) when registering. Teams playing in adult league or players playing as a call up player in adult league will need a player card. If the player card is lost, replacement cards are available at a cost of \$10. Managers are to contact FCR Youth Coordinator (<u>youth@fcregina.com</u>) 2 weeks prior to tournament/provincial start date, if player cards are required, to have the teams' player cards processed. The FCR Youth Coordinator will contact the team manager when the player cards are done.

#### Player Evaluation and Selection Process:

FC Regina players will be continually evaluated and assessed through ongoing training and match play. These evaluations and assessments will be used to make player selections for the upcoming season. Details and dates regarding Player evaluation sessions will be posted on the website <u>www.fcregina.com</u>.

#### Team Fees:

Team fees are in addition to registration fees and will be set at the start of the season by the team and collected by the team manager and/or team treasurer. Team fees can range from \$50 to upwards of \$1000.00 depending on the age/division and events the team has planned and/or entered. Team fees may include (but are not limited to) the cost for items such as:

- Tournament entry fees
- Team Personnel expenses for out-of-town travel for tournaments/PSL
- Team pictures & windup
- Other items

#### Game Kits:

New players in U9 and up will need to purchase their game kits at time of registration. Game kits will consist of 2 game jerseys (Home/Away), 1 pair of Game shorts, and 1 pair of Game socks. Cost of the Game kit is \$110.00. Replacement shorts/socks can be purchased through the Uniform Committee at <u>uniforms@fcregina.com</u>

All players in U9 and up will be required to purchase the navy-blue game socks (new this outdoor season). This will be a required purchase when you register for 2022 outdoor.

#### Training Kits:

If you are a New Player to FC Regina you will need to purchase a Training Kit (1 t-shirt, 1 pair of shorts and 1 pair of socks) cost is for individual items. Players requiring replacement items can contact the Uniform Committee at uniforms@fcregina.com. Proper footwear and shin guards are mandatory equipment and are the players/parents' responsibility to purchase. All players should have their own water bottle.

#### **Volunteer Bond:**

A \$100 volunteer bond cheque for U9 and up, post-dated to Aug. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, payable to FCR will be collected by the team manager. You are required to volunteer 1 shift per player to a maximum of 3 players. A large number of volunteers are required in order to deliver our soccer programs. Failure to meet your volunteer commitment by the end of the season will result in the cheque being cashed. Any bond cheques that are cashed and returned will be subject to a \$25.00 NSF charge. If you have no intention of volunteering your time, please choose the buyout option when registering online.
