WEATHER POLICY

INCLEMENT WEATHER OCCURRING DURING MATCH

In the event of lightning, the Canada Soccer Lightning Safety/Severe Weather Policy will be followed, please familiarize yourself with the policy here:

http://www.fcregina.com/cloud/fcregina/files/Policies/lightning_policy_e42%20%281%2_9.pdf Should the inclement weather be outside of lightning, the tournament committee, in consultation with the officials, will determine if the participants and fields are in danger should games proceed. The tournament committee reserves all rights to determine this course of action.

In the event of inclement weather occurring during a match the following principles will be adhered to in order to obtain a result:

- Should the match have been suspended or abandoned at half-time or later, the result will stand. This applies for all round robin games and playoff games.
- Should the match be suspended or abandoned prior to halftime, the result will be recorded as a 0-0 tie.

If the match is a playoff game and requires a winner, the following principles will be applied in order to determine a winner:

- 1) Penalty Kicks if determined safe to do so, the winner shall be decided by kicks taken from the penalty mark.
- 2) Previous match result the winner of the match played during the round robin between the two teams shall be awarded the win.
- 3) Goal Difference Goal difference shall be calculated by subtracting goals conceded from goals scored using round robin games. A maximum difference of 5 shall be awarded in each game.
- 4) Least Goals Against The team having conceded the fewer number of goals against during all round robin games will be determined to be the winner of the game.
- 5) Most Goals Scored The team having scored the most goals during their round robin games will be awarded the win. A maximum of five goal difference per game shall be included in this calculation.
- 6) Coin Toss A coin toss will be conducted by the official to determine a winner.

INCLEMENT WEATHER LASTING ENTIRETY OF TOURNAMENT OR DURING TRAVEL

Should the City of Regina close the fields due to the risk of fields being damaged, the tournament committee will make all reasonable efforts to accommodate games. This may include seeking out alternative fields, or shortening games to move them to turf fields.
