- It would be an advantage if you are a Feildian who has Active Start, Fundamentals, & Respect in Sport coaching certifications, and First Aid training.

- Access to a vehicle is preferable, but not mandatory.

- We are looking for people who love soccer, working with children & have a good knowledge of the game.

- Pay starts at \$16 per hour and goes up based upon your coaching experience & quality, commitment to coaching development, and whether you are assigned any supervisory / leadership roles.

- Every staff member will require an NCCP identification number. This account will hold all your coaching certifications across all sports.
- **Respect In Sport Group**
 - Everyone will need to complete the "Respect In Sport For Activity Leaders" for the NLSA online course found here: https://nlsa.respectgroupinc.com/koala_final/. There is a fee for this that will be reimbursed. Please forward your receipt to treasurer@feildians.ca when you complete the course.
- **Safe Sport**
 - The Safe Sport module is required. It is a self-directed course and is free.
