Parents Code of Conduct

Fernie Youth Soccer Association

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in soccer.
- 2. I will remember that my child plays sport for their enjoyment, not for mine.
- 3. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 4. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning and will offer praise for competing fairly and trying hard.
- 5. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other children for making a mistake or losing a competition during or after the game or practise.
- 6. I will remember that children learn best by example. I will applaud good plays/performances by both my child's team and their opponents.
- 7. I will never question the officials' judgment or honesty in public.
- 8. I will not discriminate on the basis of gender, race, age, ethnicity, ability, sexual orientation, beliefs, religious or political affiliation.
- 9. I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from children's sporting activities.
- 10. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches who give their time to provide sport activities for my child.
- 11. I will respect the oppositions' players, coaches and parents.
- 12. I will not coach my child from the sidelines, just support them positively.
- 13. I will adhere to the policies of the Fernie Youth Soccer Association defined on the FYSA website under "Bylaws, Policies, Guidelines and Codes of Conduct.". If I have questions or concerns with any aspect of the organized soccer in Fernie, I will raise my concerns with members of the board in the appropriate manner.
- 14. To ensure the protection of all children in our care, all allegations or suspicions of potentially illegal behaviour that a parent/staff/volunteer learns of must also be promptly reported to police and/or child welfare. Police and/or child welfare will make the determination as to whether the allegation or suspicion requires further investigation.
- 15. If I am not able to coach or assist on field with my child's team, I will look for opportunities to assist the coach or the association to sustain or improve soccer in Fernie.
- 16. If I am not a member of the board, I will not seek to speak on behalf of the Fernie Youth Soccer Association and ensure my opinions are clearly identified as my own.
