- Covers all league expenses
- Works out to about \$135 per girl, \$150 per boy
- Team fees paid to FHA by the team, not the athlete
- Athlete pays FHA membership on RAMP

COACHING REQUIREMENTS

- FHC Mandatory Guidelines
- Coaches must complete all courses/requirements by: Saturday, May 14, 2022
- Coaches and on-field staff that have not completed their Safesport Modules may not be on the field with athletes at games or practice
- FHA will help determine coach accreditation

SAFESPORT

- All volunteers that directly interact with athletes: assistant coaches, coaches in training, junior coaches, bench parents, onfield trainers
- Making Ethical Decisions + online evaluation
- Making Headway in Sport
- CAC Safesport
- Locker ID (NCCP)
- Police Check (volunteer letter)

COMMUNITY COACH

- each team or training group must have a head coach on the field that is at minimum fully NCCP Community Trained.
- Safesport modules
- Fundamental Movement Skills Multisport Module
- FHC Community Course (online)
- Valid First Aid training
- Emergency Action Plan (recommended)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Communicate club registration process to athletes. ● Organize/implement fee payment for their athletes ● Actively recruit athletes through try-it-frees, boot camps, affiliate sports, etc 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● FHA will promote/direct athletes to clubs starting February 14. ● FHA will provide platforms to pay for annual FHA/FHC dues ● NOTE: players and coaches must have a valid 2021-2022 membership in order to participate
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recruit & provide trained coaches that meet FHC/FHA minimum requirements (click here) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Police check referrals ● Offer hockey specific coach training
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide quality practice training for athletes as outlined by FHC/FHA hockey development criteria 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Access to age specific practice plans ● Provide on field coaching support when requested

What are the clubs responsible for?	What will FHA Provide?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide practice equipment ● Supply team uniforms ● Provide practice facility ● Coordinate volunteers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Goalie gear, field hockey balls, equipment available for rent from FHA ● Stick purchase available for individual athletes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Submit club declarations, numbers, rosters pay team fees by deadlines 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide Saturday field time for games for teams registered in CJFH league
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide FHA registered coaches and athletes for games ● Communicate to club members game time, tournaments, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Game scheduling, festival planning, umpire allocation ● Teamsnap will be provided to clubs for league use. ● FHA will communicate COVID protocols/updates to participants
