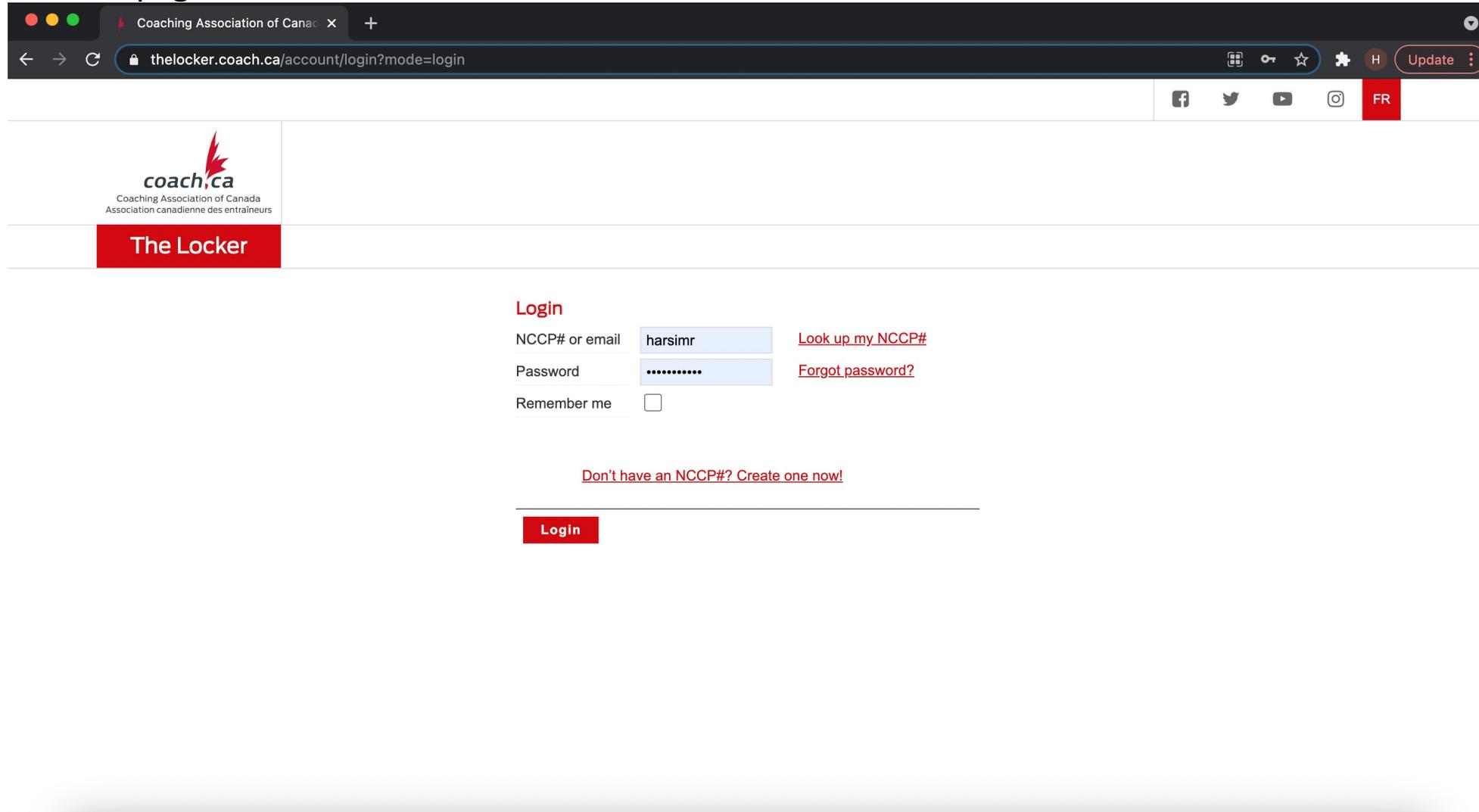


# Making Ethical Decisions (MED) Registration



1. Go to <https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login?mode=login>



### Make Ethical Decisions – 3.5 hours


This is a live, facilitator led, interactive group-based module offered online through Zoom.

- apply the NCCP Ethical Decision-Making Model to properly respond to each situation in a way that is consistent with the NCCP Code of Ethics.

11. After clicking the link, the page will redirect to look like this:




Scroll down and click "Register Now" to register for the course.




