

Here are the **Weekly Top-10 Rankings** for all five levels of high school football in Alberta l for the 2024 season. These rankings will come out every Sunday (except for Labor Day kickoff) from now up until November 3. At that time those will be the last rankings and teams will take this rank into Provincials

The 12-a-side teams are slotted into their levels based on their estimated school size by the Alberta Schools' Athletic Association while the 9 and 6-a-side are one level only. Some re-sorting of 12-a-side levels will take place after the final official population numbers are recorded at the end of September. Please note that games vs. US opponents, scrimmages, or tournaments are not taken into consideration for ranking or listed in the overall record of the schools.

A busy August for the Comets already has them at 1-1 following a close loss to #1 Harry Ainlay from Edmonton on August 23 and an annihilation of Nelson from Ontario on August 30. It's clear that last year's Provincial Tier I finalist can still pack a punch and are pressing on for another shot at the title now at the new 5A level for schools 1400 or higher despite their school population being less than 1/3 of that. To do that they must get by another powerhouse in Calgary's Notre Dame Pride. The Pride have been one of Alberta's best teams for almost two decades since they opened their doors, but they haven't been to a Provincial Final since 2015 so they too would like to begin a trail to the promised land. They are also currently the only high school team in Canada with two alumni playing in the NFL. A great game in one of Canada's best atmospheres for high school football.
