Application Guidelines

- A short, one-page memo on your thoughts on player selection, playing time for selected players, and the intent of Team Alberta. Please include your ideas on how you will build a winning culture.

 - defensive package should include terminology, fronts, coverages, and blitzes. No more than three (3) coverages, and no blitzes.
 - special teams' package should include terminology and a base look for all special teams.
