## **PLAYER AGREEMENT**

- I will avoid inappropriate behavior, including the use of profanity or other inappropriate language, during practices, games and other team activities.
- I understand that this is a competitive team therefore competing is a priority (It's not about the winning, it's about the competing.)
- I fully understand that this is a competitive team and playing time is not equal. I understand that the coaching staff has the final decision on who plays in what position and how much.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, umpires and fans at every game and practice. I will not trash talk, taunt, or root against the opposing team.
- I will refrain from outbursts against the umpire and shall let the coach handle all umpire issues.
- I will help maintain order and cleanliness of the team dugout, by picking up any loose equipment.
- I will help to ensure that we leave the dugout neater than we found it.
- I will encourage my parents to be involved in my team in some capacity because it is important to me.

- I fully understand that this is a competitive team and playing time is not equal. I understand that the coaching staff has the final decision on who plays in what position and how much.
- I will have tactful, quiet, one-on-one discussions of any concerns with the team manager/coaches when appropriate, preferably after a 24-hour period.
- I will not argue with the coach in public, as this is detrimental to getting a successful resolution.
- I will remember that only nine players can play at one time.
- I will be on time to all events.
- I will try to arrange for alternate transportation if my child can't get to a practice/game on time so that they can have the necessary warm up.
- I will notify the coaches of any absences as soon as I become aware of them.
- I will remember that the game is for the players.
