



PLAYER TRANSFER POLICY

In each instance where it is proposed that a player be registered with a baseball association other than Fort McMurray Minor Baseball Association for reasons other than his or her family relocating or to play at a higher level (i.e highest level offered by Fort McMurray Minor Baseball Association at time of request is AA and player moves to play AAA) that player shall comply with the procedure described below:

1. Register with Fort McMurray Minor Baseball Association (\$25.00 administration fee is applied if application is successful)
2. Players must first notify their Home Association President or designate of their intent to Request a transfer
3. Request a transfer as per baseball Alberta regulations and submit to your home association - [Player Transfer Form](#)
4. With transfer application provide a letter to your home association explaining the reason for the request
5. Submit letter from proposed new association showing their support of the transfer
6. Meet any other requirements as per Baseball Alberta Handbook - [Player Transfers](#)

Documents to be submitted to the Player Movement Committee

The Player Movement Committee shall consist of, ***at a minimum***, the President, Vice-President, Executive Director of Operations, Competitive Director and two other board members. The committee will meet at the call of the President as required by the volume of Applications.

Where an application is rejected due to lack of information and the applicant is able to provide the committee with additional information, the committee will reevaluate the application within 10 days of receipt of the additional information.

The Player Movement Committee shall have the authority to refuse any player movement, giving cause. Decisions of the Committee are not subject to appeal with Fort McMurray Minor Baseball Association.
