- NEW to ringette Active Start and U10 player rate is \$245.
- NEW to ringette U12-U19 player rate is the "early registration rate".
- Credit card will be the only form of payment accepted online, other forms of payment must be arranged with the Fort Saskatchewan Minor Sports Association Office email <a href="mailto:fsmsa@telus.net">fsmsa@telus.net</a> or phone 780.998.1835.
  - Three payments may be made by postdated cheques to the FSMSA office and must be in by June 1st to be eligible for early rates. All returned cheques will be assessed an NSF charge (\$35.00) as per MSA policy.
- Starting June 1<sup>st</sup> the regular registration rate will apply for all returning players.

Registration fees must be paid in full before October 1, 2019. Any unpaid fees will result in a suspension from FRSA until accounts are in good standing.

## **INCLUDED IN REGISTRATION**

- Power Skating 8-10 sessions (excluding Active Start)
- FSRA Goalie Camps

### ADDITIONAL COSTS AT TIME OF REGISTRATION

- Participation Cheque \$300 per family (submitted to Team Manager, post-dated March 1/2020)
- Fundraising Fee of \$50/player (additional charge at time of registration, on the RAMP Registration Platform)
- All families are required to buy 2 Pub Night Tickets, at a cost of \$15 each. (additional charge at the time of registration, on the RAMP Registration Platform)

The Participation cheque collected at registration is to ensure that every family supports the FSRA in fundraising and volunteer activities. Some examples of ways to earn participation hours for the FSRA are:

- working a casino or Oilers 50/50, if available
- working the concession at the Chiefs games
- working the provincial tournament (should FSRA host Provincials at any age level)
- coach, assistant coach or manager of a team
- becoming a member of the executive

## **LATE REGISTRATION FEES**

Late Registration Fees are as follows:

- Register prior to October 31 pay 100% of the registration fee
- Register prior to November 30 pay 90% of the registration fee
- Register prior to January 1 75% of the registration fee
- Register after December 31 60% of the registration fee

#### **REFUND POLICY**

The refund policy consists of a percentage off of the registration fee only being returned. Any additional administration fees from the MSA office are the responsibility of the registrant and will be deducted at that time:

- withdraw by August 31 90 % registration fee refunded (less \$20 processing fee)
- withdraw by September 15 75% registration fee refunded (less \$20 processing fee)
- withdraw by November 15 50% registration fee refunded (less \$20 processing fee)
- withdraw after November 15 no refund

Registration fees, participation hours and additional fees are set each season by the executive prior to early registration. This could include the addition of stipulations that may change the way the membership will qualify for the early registration discount.

## **NEW TO THE 2019 / 2020 SEASON**

FSRA has joined the Castledowns Bingo Association!!! Every participant will be expected to provide an adult (over the age of 18) to complete a volunteer shift at a FSRA hosted bingo.

Please note: these hours will **NOT** be counted as part of the mandatory 10 volunteer hours.
