## COACHES! Your NCCP status(es) might be expired!

You won't have to re-take the coaching courses, but you will need to work on some Professional Development (PD) and get points and renew your status(es).

<u>Until you get enough points you are ineligible to coach.</u>


Note: many coaches who have a CSI (U10, U12B/C) status expiring are only coaching at the CI (U12A, U14, U16, U19) level and do not need the CSI status. While we recommend renewing anyway, it will not affect your ability to coach at a CI level if your CSI expires.

Remember: Your ALL-TIME points (as shown on the coach.ca home page) are not important. Only the points that are accumulated during the 5-year cycle of a status count towards its renewal.


Go into your profile and check the certification tab.



To make sure, log into your <a href="www.coach.ca">www.coach.ca</a> locker account and check your transcript. If you see this, it means you need more points:



This (below) means you have a certain number of years to accumulate 10/20/30 points. It's a 5-year cycle starting from the time you achieve your status, or following renewal. If you have all the points, then come the expiry year, you will automatically renew.





You can also self-declare points for years of active coaching. In your locker account, under the certification tab, click on the self-report whistle – you can claim 1 point per year during the 5-year cycle of a coaching status.
