## How to Verify/Call-back a bingo?

- ANY and ALL volunteers (ushers) on the floor can/should be prepared to do bingo call backs
- It is VERY important to always be moving and to get to the winners quickly to call back the numbers
- ALWAYS keep your hand raised until you've called your bingo and call numbers in clear, loud voice

On the pic below there is a number in the bottom corner (69036). This is the number you call, say the card colour and IF calling from the paper the row it is in. For example, "69036 on gold card middle row". Then the caller will say, "that's a good bingo." Speciality bingos like balls, casino, double action etc. may have the number on back of the card

You can call bingo from the computer screen and the player points out the winning one or from paper copies.

You then take their "receipt" pictured below to the Paymaster for their winnings and then bring the winnings and the receipt back to the winner. Speciality bingo's (casino, balls, double action) will require the actual winning card and the receipt to be brought to paymaster/cage area)
