Safety Reminders

- Whether you are walking through a parking lots or crossing a street, parents please keep an eye on your little soccer stars.
- Please remember to park safely and legally! Bylaw will ticket people for not following parking by laws.
- Shin pads are to be worn at games and practices by all players. This is an Alberta Soccer rule and it
 needs to be followed for insurance reasons. Shin pads are to be worn underneath the soccer sock and
 not on top of the sock.
- If you see lightening or hear thunder at all your Coaches for U3 -U7 will call the game. Everyone must immediately leave the field. For U9-U19 the Referees will call the games (coaches will call practices). You must leave the field. You will not be permitted to resume the game or practice until 30 minutes after the last strike of lightening. This is an Alberta Soccer rule every team must adhere to the LIGHTNING POLICY

Other Important Field Reminders

None of these are permitted at any field:

- Alcohol
- Vaping
- Smoking
- Marijuana
- Sunflower Seeds

Some EMSA fields and Taurus Field in Fort Saskatchewan do not allow your pets to be present at the fields.

If you are at a Fort Saskatchewan field (other than Taurus field), your pets are welcome, but the must be always leashed, and you must pick up after them!

Please remember when you are watching your child's games you are representing Fort Saskatchewan Soccer. While we encourage you to cheer on your child, please do not sideline coach. If you have an issue with a Fort Saskatchewan referee, please email the referee coordinator or vice president. If you have an issue with another parent, please talk to your referee liaison.

Interested in where your soccer fees go?

As a non-for-profit organization, we need to fundraise to cover expenses your fees do not cover such as equipment and our technical program with **Soccer Is Everything.** Your Fees go towards:

- Alberta Soccer Association and Canadian Soccer Association compulsory fees for membership and insurance.
- Tri-County league fees and Edmonton league fees fees associated with each of the leagues in which we play.
- Coach training related fees: ASA instructor fees for coach courses, gym and meeting room rentals, coach packages, soccer program information packages, t-shirts.
- Center Referee and Assistant Referee fees, ASA instructor fees for referee courses, gym and meeting room rentals for training courses, and referee equipment.
- Alberta Soccer Rural or Cities Provincials participation fees.
- Soccer's portion of Minor Sports Association administrative costs including staffing, accounting services, office rental, meeting rooms, telephone, fax, internet, webpage, postage and other administrative fees.
- Jerseys and equipment for our referees.
- Field lining services, paint, equipment, line painting machine, and machine maintenance.
- Indoor soccer field rentals for games and practices.
- Facility rentals for referee courses, coach & player clinics and player assessments.
- Meeting Room and gym rentals for Executive Committee meetings, coach meetings and training, team, selections and various other meetings.
- Costs associated with registration, such as: print and sign advertising, printing of forms and information packages, electronic payment and registration systems, credit card fees.




