

Player Conduct Agreement

(Mosquito to Midget)

I understand that I am a part of the Fredericton Minor Baseball Association (FMBA). I agree to conduct myself as follows:

- 1. Team members must attend practices and scheduled team meetings to earn the rights to play in games.
- 2. The amount of playing time during games is determined after the coach has assessed the player's skills and determination in practice, punctuality, and preparedness (*arriving with the right equipment*). Not all players will receive equal playing time in all games. Questions regarding playing time should be addressed to the Coach.
- 3. A player unavailable for a game or practice will advise the Coach or Team Manager in advance.
- 4. Players must show respect to team-mates, other teams' players, umpires and game officials, coaches, spectators and the public at all times.
- 5. Players will be supportive of their own teammates and courteous to other teams. The public judges the FMBA by the teams and individuals who represent the Association.
- 6. Players will not use disrespectful language and will not verbally or physically harass or abuse in any way, teammates, other players, coaches, umpires or spectators.

Note:

Violations may result in suspension by a Coach or Coordinator. (not more than 48 hours, without the authorization of the Disciplinary Committee)

Serious violations will be addressed by the Disciplinary Committee who may authorize a further suspension, pending the outcome of the investigation according to the by-laws and constitution.

Appeal of the decision may be made to the President of the Association (*President does not participate in decisions of the Association Disciplinary Committee*)
