

FSJ MINOR HOCKEY CLINIC REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Volunteer Requirements:

HEAD COACH & Assistant Coaches

- criminal record check
- completion of coaching course COACH 2 for Novice and above (formerly known as HYBRID and/or STREAM) or registered to do so (final opportunity to take coaching clinic is often mid-November)
- CATT Concussion Awareness Training Tool certificate
- Respect In Sport (RIS) (or Speak Out) certificate
- Initiation coaches require Coach 1, CATT, RIS and CRC

ON ICE HELPERS – On-ice helpers are not approved to be on bench during games, only during practice.

- Criminal record check
- Respect In Sport certificate
- CATT

HCSP (Hockey Canada Safety Person)

- criminal record check,
- Hockey Canada Safety Program (HCSP) course completion
- CATT Concussion Awareness Training Tool certificate
- Respect In Sport certificate

From the list above, confirm which Volunteer Role you are considering helping with and the Instructions below will help you navigate to the required course, online registration, etc. Scroll down to the required information and follow the instructions provided to assist.

All Course fees will be reimbursed. Print off your payment receipt and bring to FSJ Minor Hockey Office for refund. COACH 2 Refunds will be provided once you have completed your Post Task.

CATT Concussion Awareness Training Tool is FREE.

All Volunteers are required to provide a valid Criminal Record Check – FSJ Minor Hockey Expiry is 3 years for Criminal Record Checks.

CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK:

If you require a Criminal Record Check completed for BC Hockey, it should be done through the Ministry of Justice website using the following procedure.


- Visit the Ministry of Justices website https://justice.gov.bc.ca/eCRC/
- Scroll to BC Criminal Record Check Process
- Enter FSJ unique access code A9AVJ2AHFY
- Click Share the result of a Competed Criminal Record Check

Once complete the results will be delivered directly to BC Hockey's authorized contact person for privacy and confidentiality.


The Ministry of Justice online Criminal Records Review Program allows you to share your CRC between organizations that are enrolled in the online service and additional information can be found on their website.

To access on-line Clinics and Register for Coaching Clinic – go to BCHockey.net – and from the screen below, select 'Clinics'




In center of the screen, you will see all the Clinic Registration links. Follow the link and




COACH 2 – COACHING CLINIC


Select the CLICK HERE button shown in above screen shot, you will be taken to the screen below, please select North East Yukon:



You will get the below screen, in the Type field – do the drop down and select *COACH 2 – COACH LEVEL

Proceed by selecting 'Signup' in the far right hand column. Please read all details as you are required to do a PRE-TASK for this course.



IF you do not do this POST-Task, you will have to do the whole thing over again if you wish to Coach next season.

CATT – Concussion Awareness Training Tool

From the BC Hockey Clinic Screen (shown on page 2 of this document) select the CLICK HERE button under the 'To register for CATT', you will be taken to the following screen, Select the HTTP site and you will be provided instructions on how to proceed.

This is approximately 30 minutes with a short quiz at end to finalize your certification.




CATT Training is FREE, no reimbursement required.

RESPECT IN SPORT


From the BC Hockey Clinic Screen (shown on page 2 of this document) select the CLICK HERE button under the 'To register for Respect in Sport', you will be taken a screen that requests you to read Important Information before proceeding, at the bottom of that screen you will select CLICK HERE again to proceed.

HCSP – Hockey Canada Safety Person

From the BC Hockey Clinic Screen (shown on page 2 of this document) select the CLICK HERE button under the 'To register for HCSP Clinic', in the Search Clinics section, Type field – select *HU – ONLINE Safety and then select SEARCH



Select 'Signup' in the Results Section and in the screen below that pops up, select Applicable Division – Initiation parents can select 'Pre-Novice' and proceed by selecting 'Next'



You will then need to sign up for the clinic by logging into an existing account or creating a new account. If you are creating a new account, please make sure you save the information somewhere so when you need to go in again for different clinic or recertification, you use the same user name/account.
