Step 1: Confirm Eligibility

- · You must be a resident of British Columbia to register for and attend the On-Field Practical Workshop.
- Age Requirement:
 - Active Start & Fundamentals: 14 years or olderLearn to Train & Soccer for Life: 16 years or older

Step 2: Determine What Age Group You Will Be Coaching

U6: Active Start

U7-U8: Fundamentals

U9-U12: Learn to Train

U13+: Soccer for Life

Step 3: Create A Coach Centre Account/Update Information

- · <u>CLICK HERE</u> to create an account or login if you have an existing account.
- Once logged in click the My Profile > Profile tab in the top left corner of the page.
- Update your **name**, **email** and **NCCP Number** on your profile.
- · Click Submit.

Step 4: Complete The Online Theory Component (Part 1)

- · <u>CLICK HERE</u> to select the appropriate course and complete the payment process.
- · You will be sent an email from noreply@smarteru.com please follow the instructions on the email.
 - **IMPORTANT:** please make sure when registering for a Canada Soccer SmarterU account that <u>your name</u> and <u>email</u> are identical to <u>your name</u> and <u>primary</u> email on Coach Centre.

- **IMPORTANT:** Please make sure that you select your soccer club when registering for a Canada Soccer SmarterU account.
- You will need to complete Coaching Soccer In Canada (only once) before you will be able to access and complete any of the 4 Grassroots Coaching Courses applicable to you.
- · Once you have completed any of the 4 Grassroots Online Theory Coaching Courses, you will be given credit for the Online Theory certification in Coach Centre (this may take up to a week).

Step 5: Complete The On-Field Practical Workshop (Part 2)

 - **IMPORTANT:** You will only be able to register for workshops on Coach Centre once you have completed the Online Theory pre-requisite for the appropriate Grassroots level and it is displayed on your Coach Centre account.
 - **IMPORTANT:** If you are not associated with a soccer club, you are still able to register but you will need to email the host of the applicable workshop directly and inquire if you can attend. If they allow you to attend, they will provide you with the code to register.
