2024 NIYSA Scholarship Application

The Northern Interior Youth Soccer Association (NIYSA) is proud to award scholarships to our Northern BC graduating players/referees/coaches continuing to post-secondary education. Up to \$5000.00 may be granted to applicants in 2024 by the Northern Interior Youth Soccer Association (NIYSA).

- Applications must be received on or before Saturday, August 10th, 2024.
- All applications must be completed in full to qualify.

Recipients and amounts of the scholarships will be determined through NIYSA's evaluations of the following eligibility and application rules.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants are required to have played three (3) or more years with a currently affiliated NIYSA Club/Team in good standing.
- Priority is given to those currently playing youth soccer, but participation may also be as a coach, official, or volunteer.
- Applicants must demonstrate a focus on academic excellence and maintain a minimum 'B' average.
- Applicants must show examples of community involvement (e.g., volunteering) and maintain good citizenship, character, and integrity.
- Applicants must be graduating from a sanctioned College or University program in:
 - Canada
 - United States
 - Europe

<u>NOTE</u>: Scholarships will be held until September 30th of the year in which they are awarded. September 30th is the deadline for proof of registration to be provided to the NIYSA Head Office. If proof of registration is not provided by said date, the scholarship will be forfeited.

Application Rules

- Applicant is required to provide a minimum of two (2) references that can confirm the applicant's:
 - o character
 - o past and current involvement in the game of soccer
 - o involvement in the community
- o All sections of the application must be completed in full
- A written letter/cover letter and resume must be provided with the application that outlines the required information and post-secondary plan.


