1.0 Purpose

To outline the Fort Saskatchewan Minor Sports Association's (FSMSA) policy regarding the annual adjustment of all administration and membership fees.

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all of the Minor Sport programs under the umbrella of the FSMSA, currently including baseball, fastball, gymnastics, hockey, judo, lacrosse, ringette, soccer and any other Minor Sports that may join the FSMSA.

3.0 Terms

Operational Expenses – The ongoing costs of running the FSMSA.

Administration Fees – The fees charged on an annual basis to the Minor Sport programs to operate the FSMSA Office.

Membership Fee – A fee charged to families in order to be eligible participants in any FSMSA Minor Sport program.

4.0 Policy

- 4.1 The FSMSA Board of Directors will annually review the Operational Expenses of the FSMSA Office, and adjust the Administration Fees collected from each Minor Sport in accordance with Policy #2080 – Budget Policy.
- 4.2 The FSMSA Board of Directors will review the FSMSA Membership Fee annually and implement changes as determined.
- 4.3 If a member resigns from the FSMSA and revokes the membership, they can receive a reimbursement of the Membership Fee provided that the family has not and will not be participating in any Minor Sport under the umbrella of the FSMSA. However, withdrawal of membership does not waive any debts owed to the FSMSA.
