1.0 Purpose

To define the membership and registration criteria for the Fort Saskatchewan Minor Sports Association (FSMSA).

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all members of the FSMSA including current members and those that seek membership in the future.

3.0 Terms

Membership – Those members described in <u>Article 2.1 of Bylaws</u> and <u>4.1 of this Policy</u>.

Good standing - A member who has paid the annual Membership Fee. Any member who has been found guilty of violating the Bylaws or Policies and Procedures of the FSMSA shall no longer be considered to be in Good Standing.

4.0 Policy

- 4.1 Membership in the FSMSA is automatic for:
 - a. All participants in any Minor Sport program under the umbrella of the FSMSA.
 - b. The Parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s) of each participant.
 - c. FSMSA Board members, Minor Sports program executive members, coaches, officials, referees, volunteers, and administrators providing service for the FSMSA or any minor sport program under its umbrella.
- 4.2 Membership is open to all residents of Alberta who have registered and paid all applicable fees to participate in a Minor Sport program under the umbrella of FSMSA.
- 4.3 Membership fees will be reviewed and set annually by the FSMSA Board of Directors and may be subject to change. All memberships expire on Dec 31 of the year in which they are issued. However, membership privileges will continue until the conclusion of the sport program in which the member is registered, if that season extends beyond December 31.
- 4.4 At the time of registration, all members must be in good standing with all FSMSA sports.
